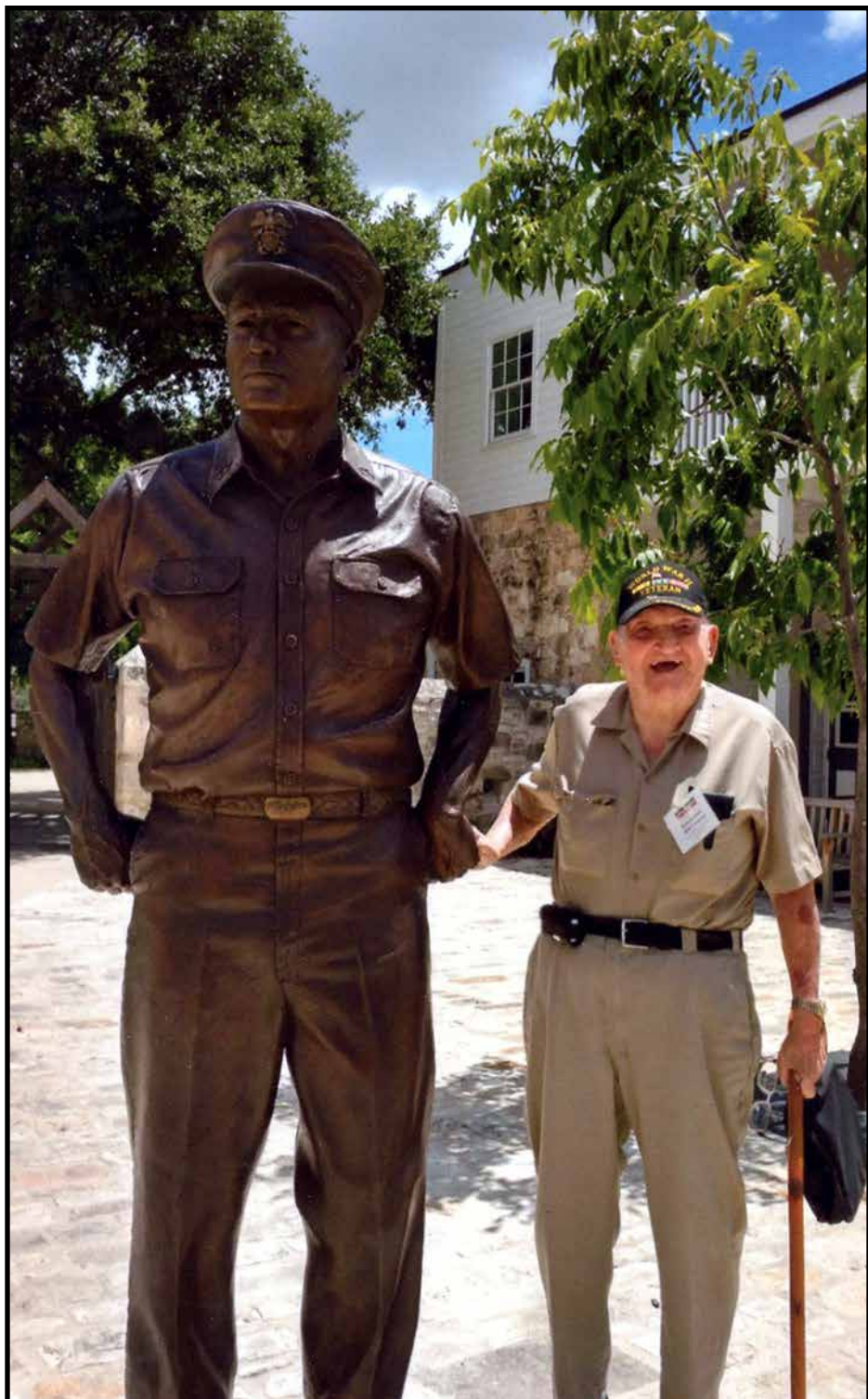
He is preceded in death by his wife, Mattie Eakes; parents, and brother.
