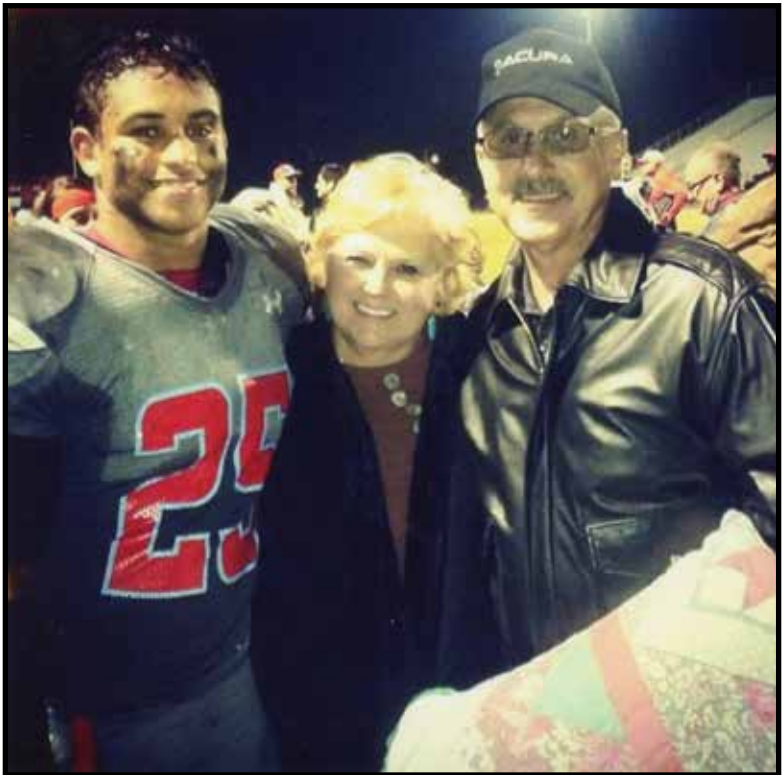
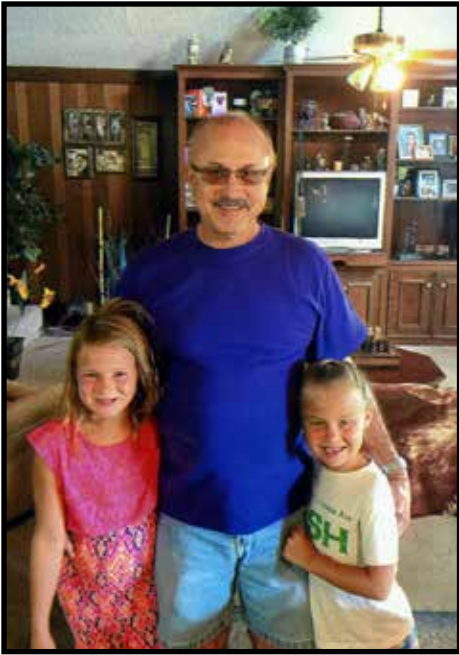
He is preceded in death by his wife, Kathy Gallier; mother, Willie Ann Decker; and brothers, Rodger Gallier and Mark Acree.





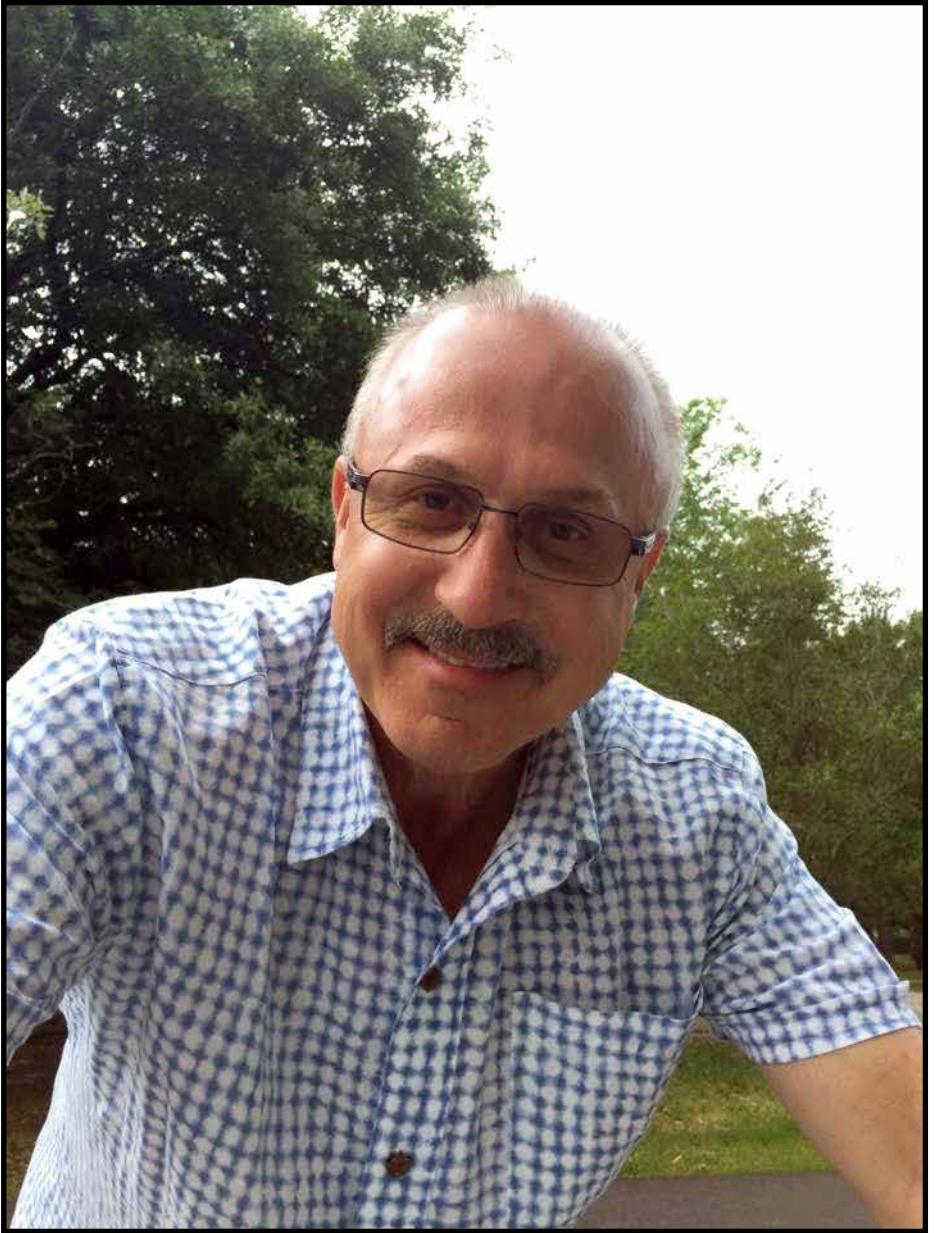
