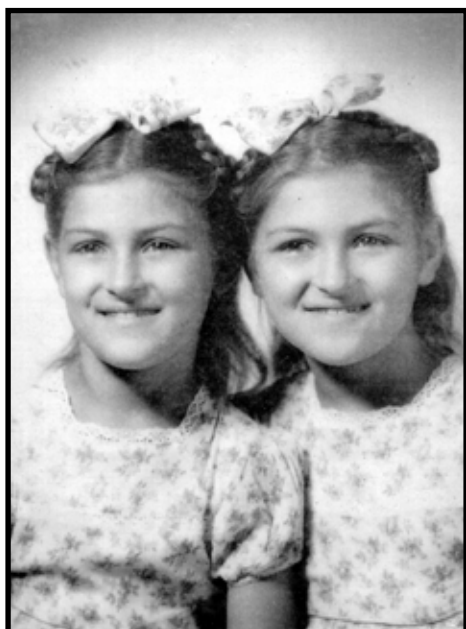
Lillia Marie “MawMaw”

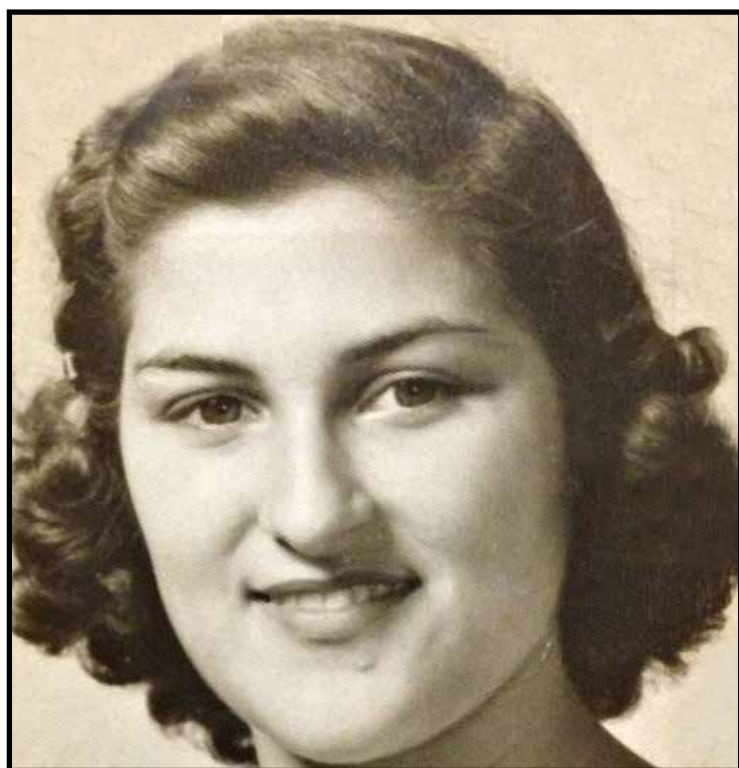
