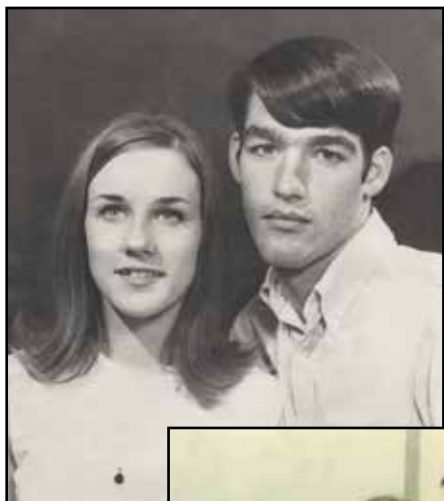

Marlon is preceded in death by his parents and his brother, James Nathan Hall.

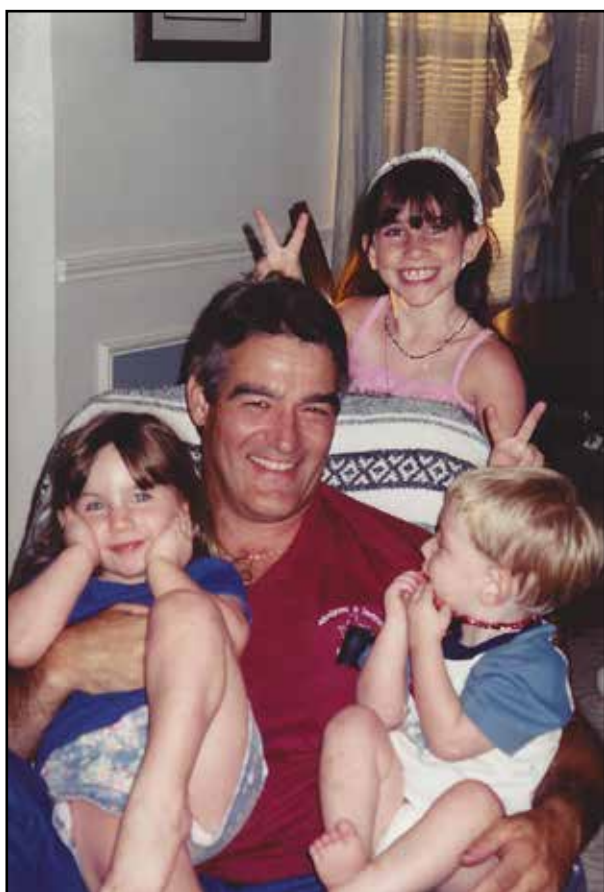

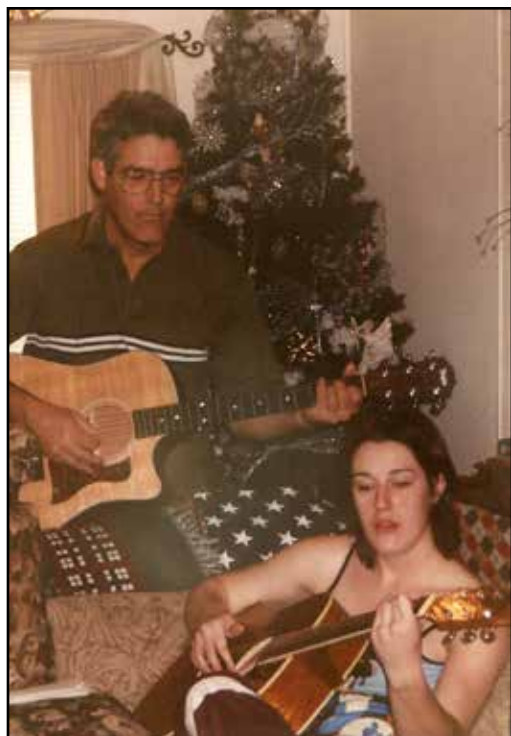














Which have been the most interesting times during your life with Mom?
