He married his high school sweetheart, Myra Medina, in 1990. They had three sons who Randy loved with all his heart. In 2005,

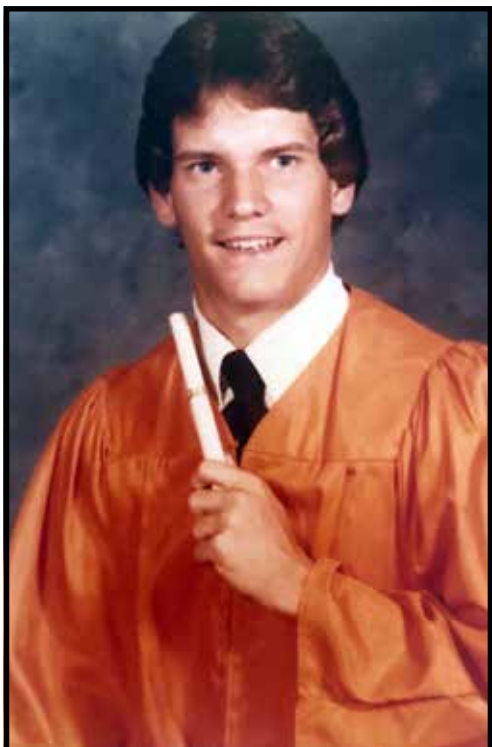
Myra went to be with Jesus. Randy poured his life into his sons, and they have grown to be young men their father was extremely proud of.

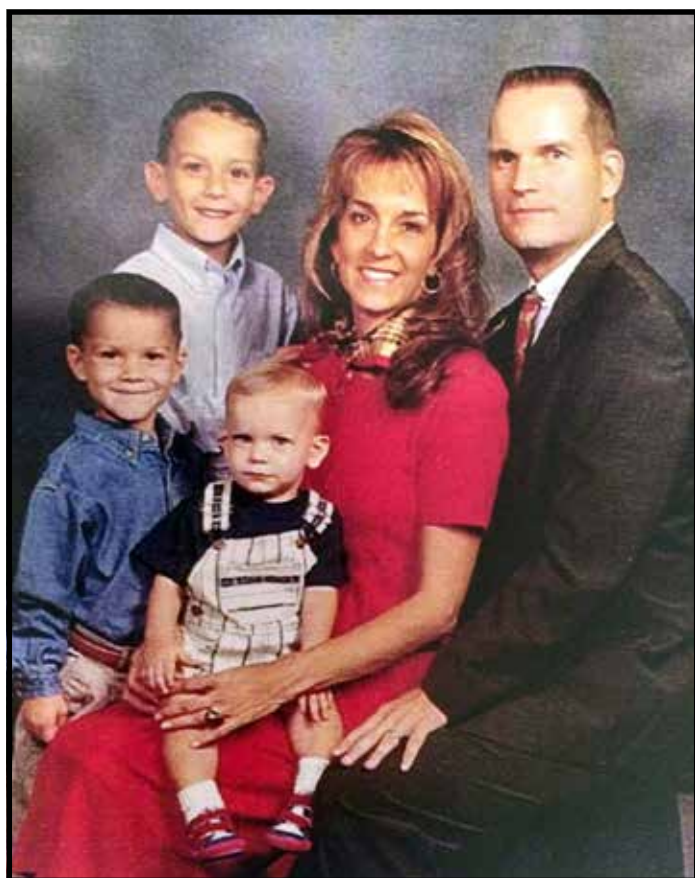
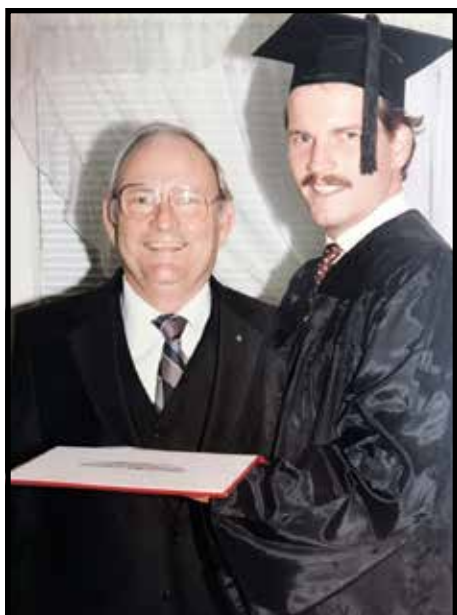

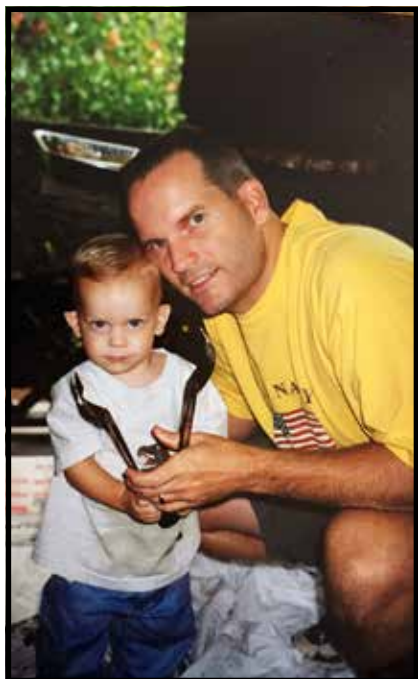

He is preceded in death by his wife, Myra Reese and father, Henry Clay Reese.

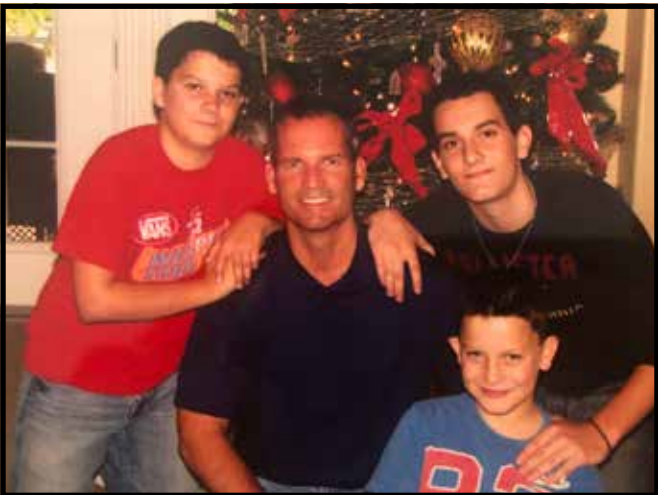
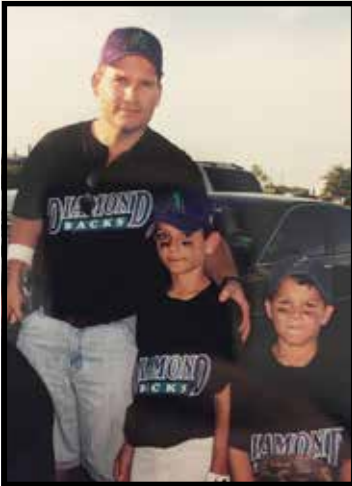


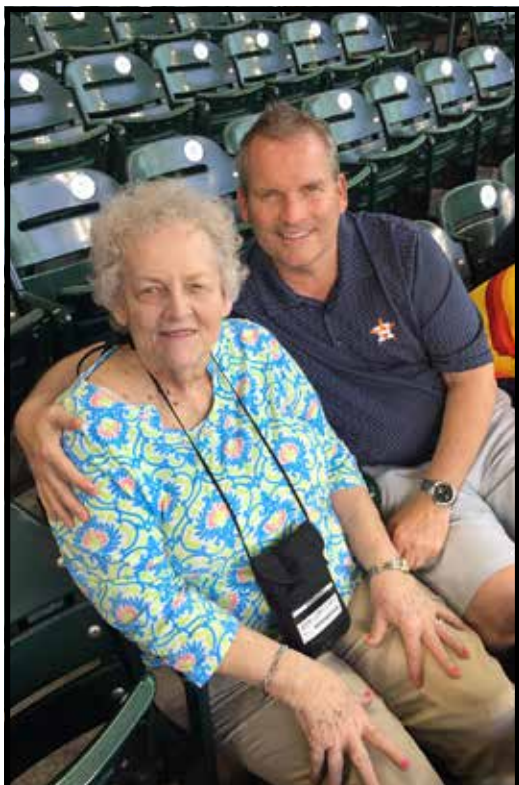
