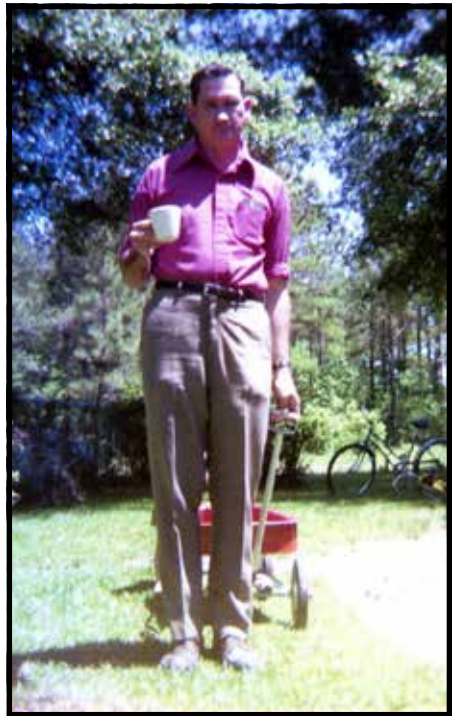

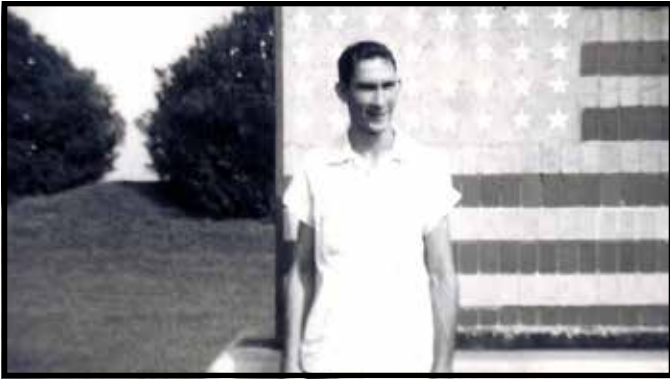

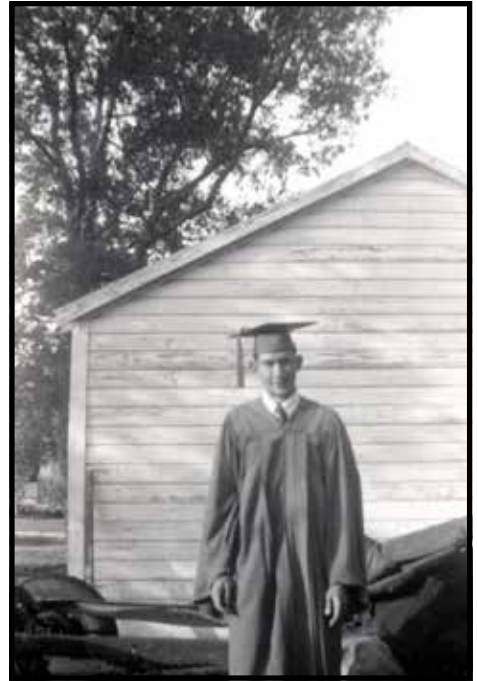
Survivors include his wife, Marie Weeks; children, Ricky Weeks and his wife, Patricia, of Broussard, Louisiana; Deanna Kay Moore

220 FM 105.

Get on I-10 W/US-90 W in Vidor 20 min (17.3 mi)

1. Head southwest on FM 105 S toward Co Rd 854
Pass by Subway (on the right in 15.6 mi) 16.6 mi
2. Turn right onto W Fwy Blvd S 0.6 mi
3. Use the left lane to take the Interstate 10 W/U.S. 90 W ramp 0.1 mi

Follow I-10 W and US-287 S/US-69 S/US-96 S to Texas 73 Access Rd in Port Arthur. Take the exit toward TX-347/Nederland from TX-73 E 25 min (28.2 mi)

4. Merge onto I-10 W/US-90 W
Continue to follow I-10 W 10.2 mi
5. Keep right at the fork to continue on US-287 S/US-69 S/US-96 S, follow signs for Port Arthur 16.2 mi
6. Take the exit onto TX-73 E toward Groves 1.8 mi
7. Take the exit toward TX-347/Nederland 0.1 mi

Drive to 39th St in Groves 2 min (0.5 mi)

8. Merge onto Texas 73 Access Rd 0.2 mi
9. Turn right onto TX-347 E 0.2 mi
10. Turn left after Jack in the Box (on the right) 0.2 mi
