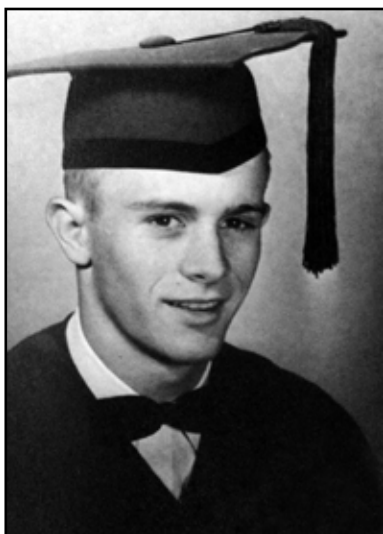

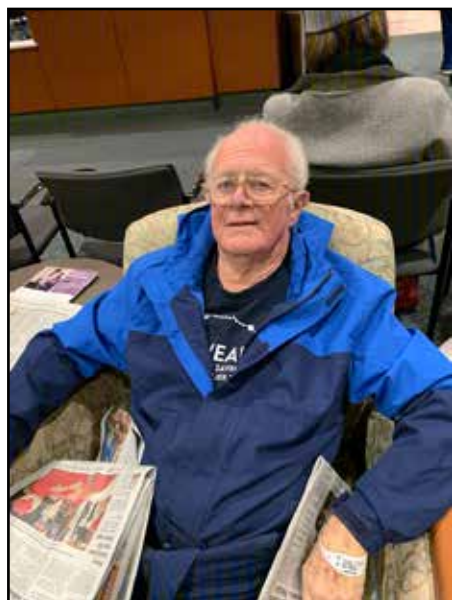

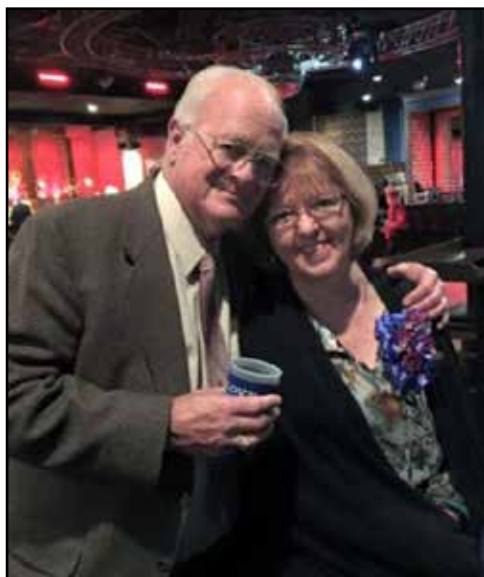
Fred is preceded in death by his parents and brother, Thomas Fischer.
