The family would like to express our appreciation and thanks for the exceptional care of our father to Dr. Nedrana Boutte.

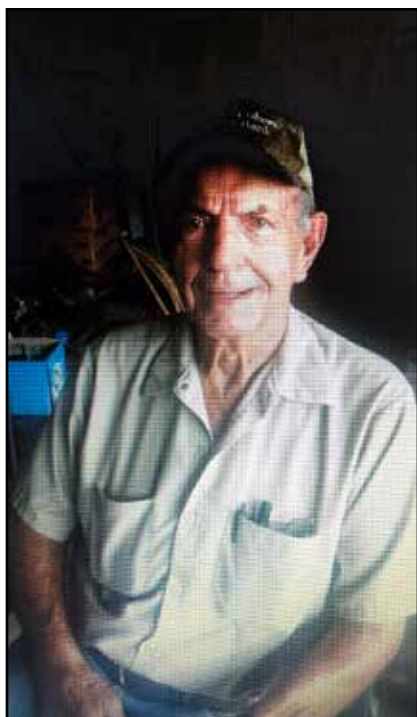
