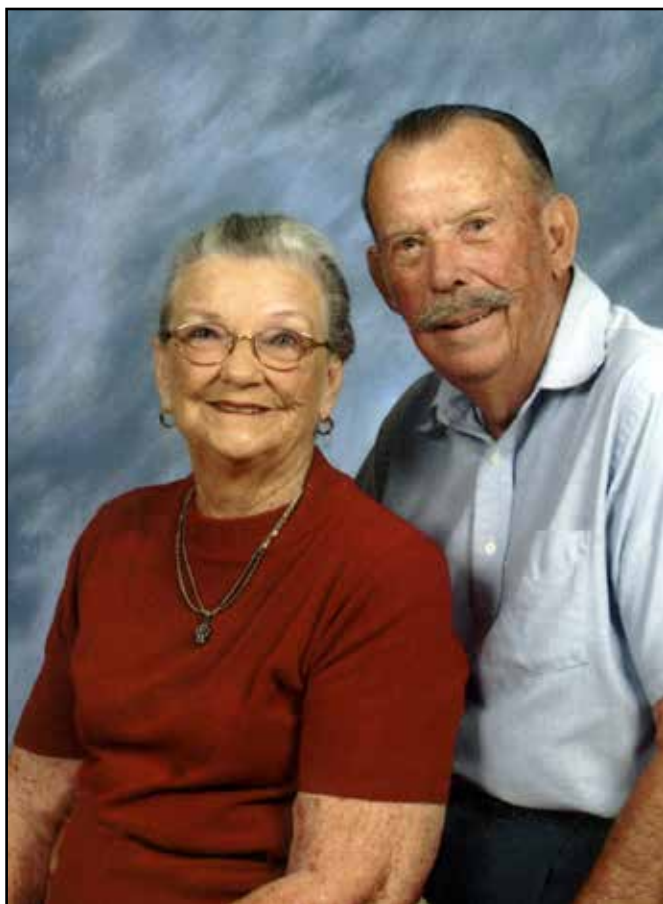

She is preceded in death by her daughter, Karen McLendon LeGros.

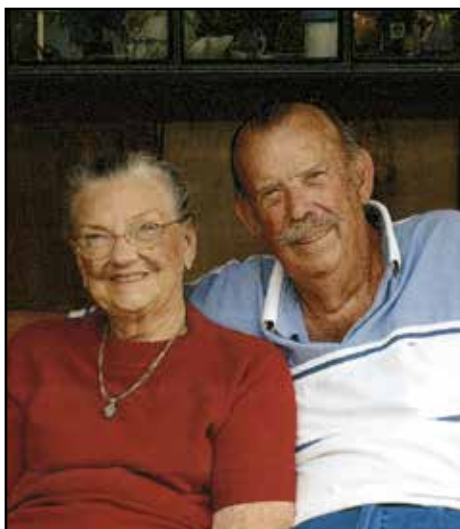
