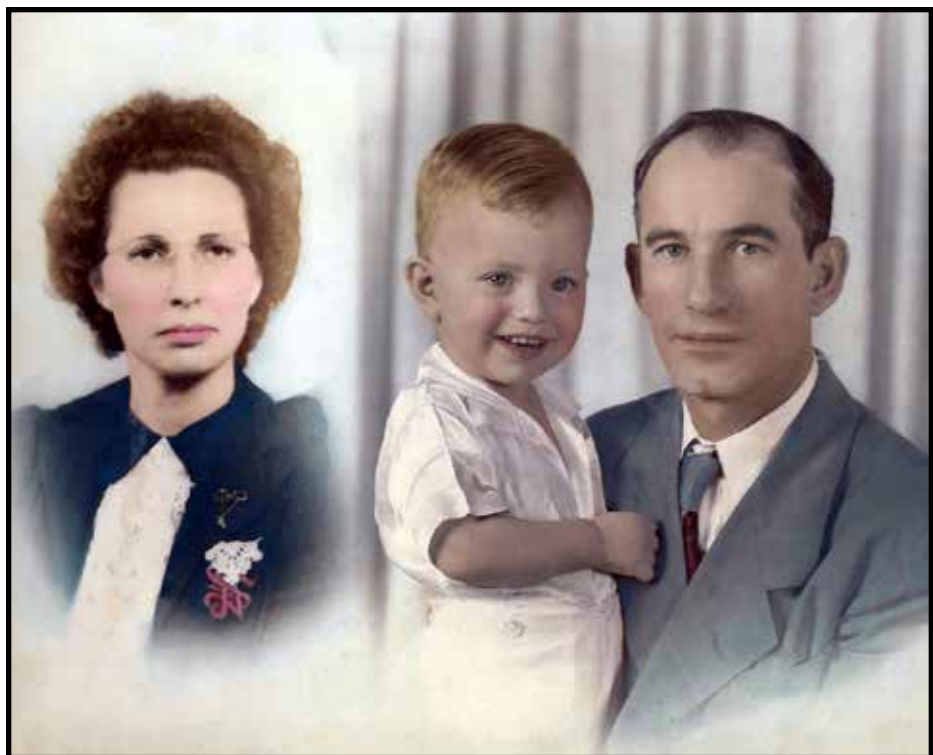

After graduation, Joe enlisted in the United States Air Force and served during the Vietnam War as an aircraft electrician until he was honorably discharged in 1974. 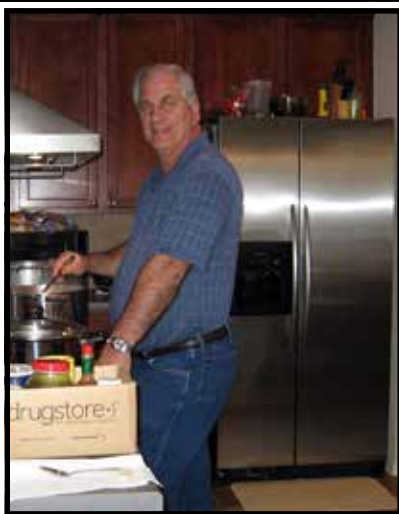
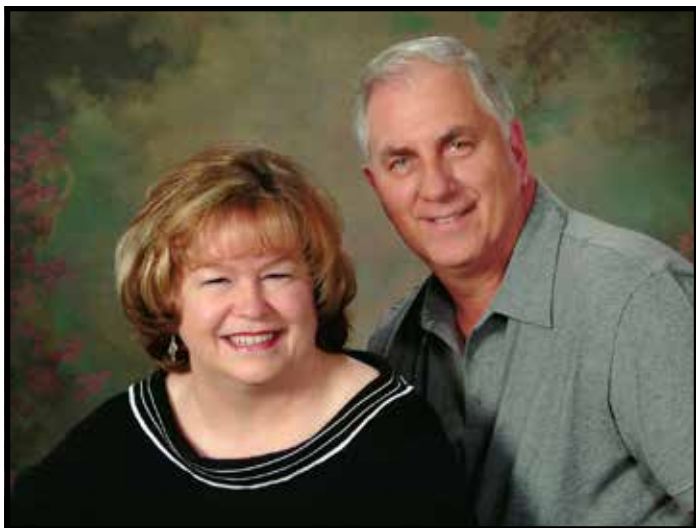

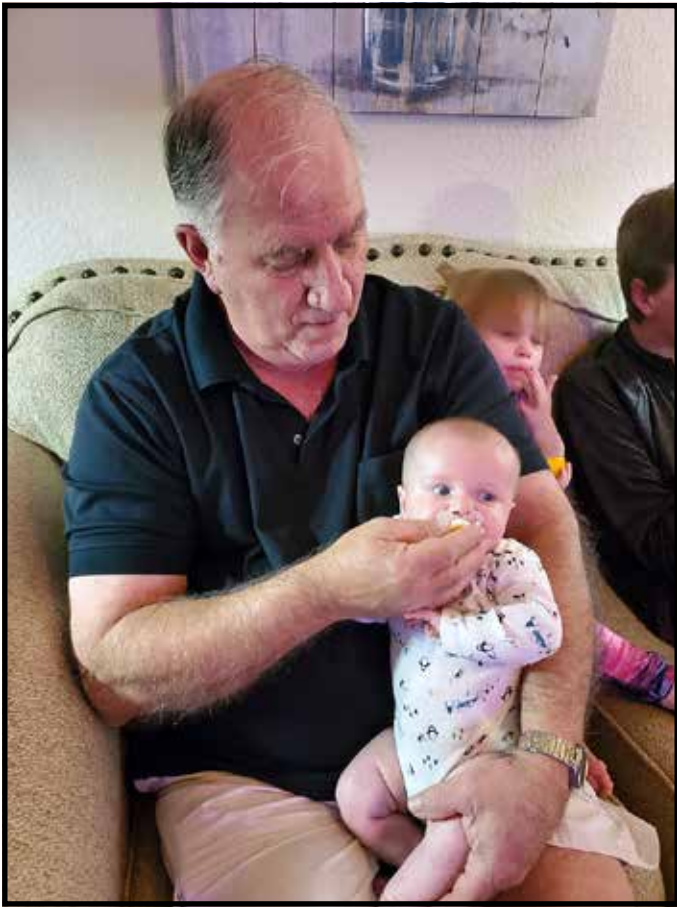
