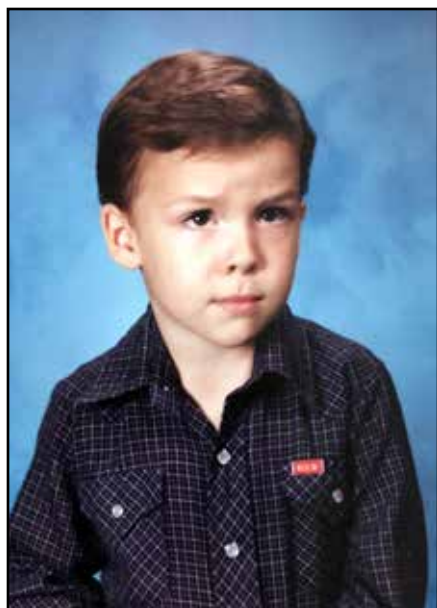

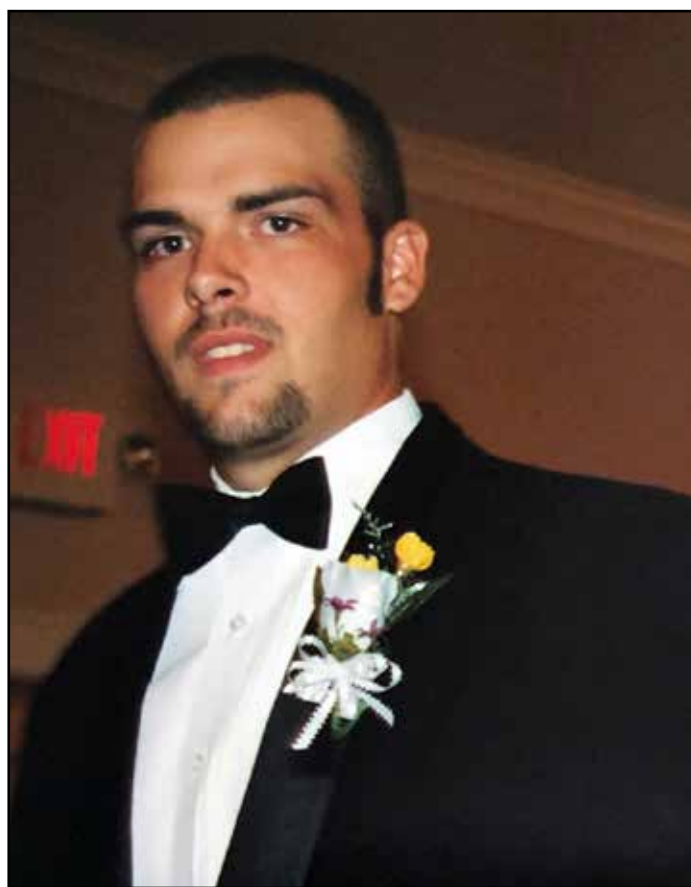

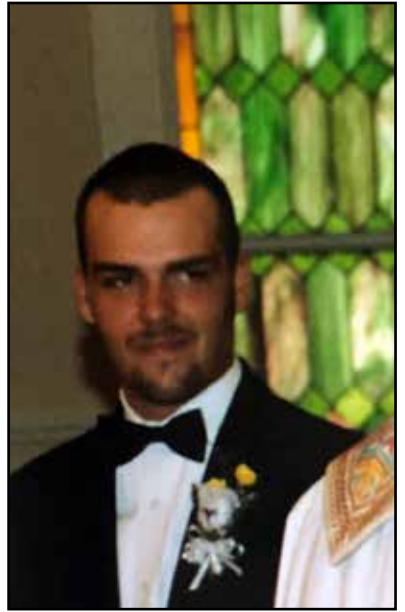
all day in the kitchen preparing and cooking. He loved to share his meal with others and was always pleased with the compliments of a well-done dinner.
