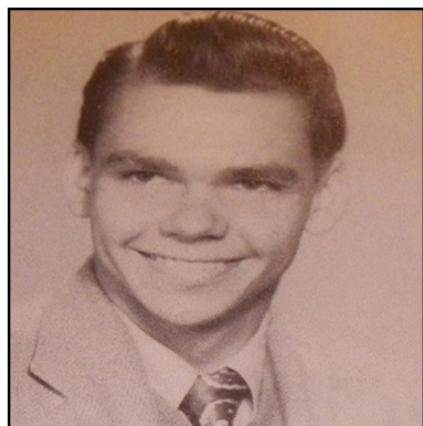

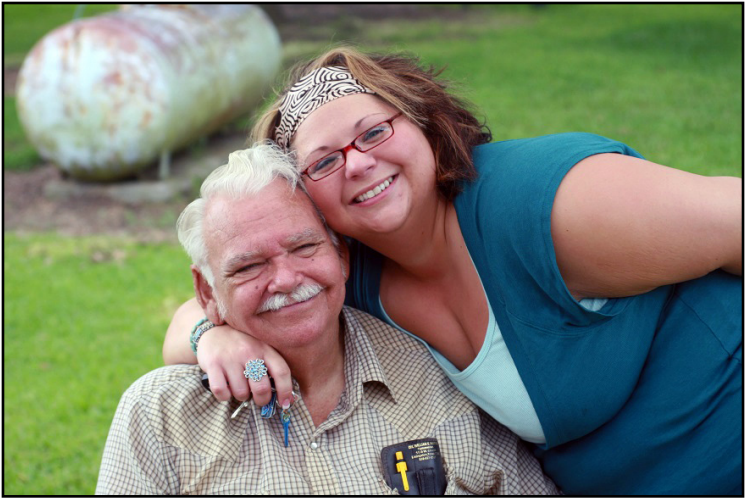
He is preceded in death by his parents; and sisters, Florence Owens and Lucille Powers.

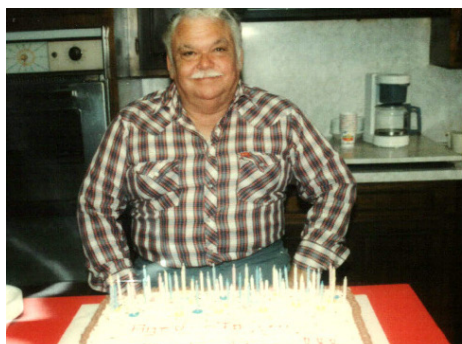


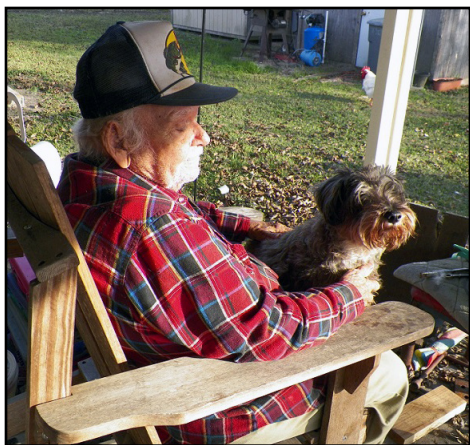
