He was preceded in death by his brothers, Frederick and Charles Adams.











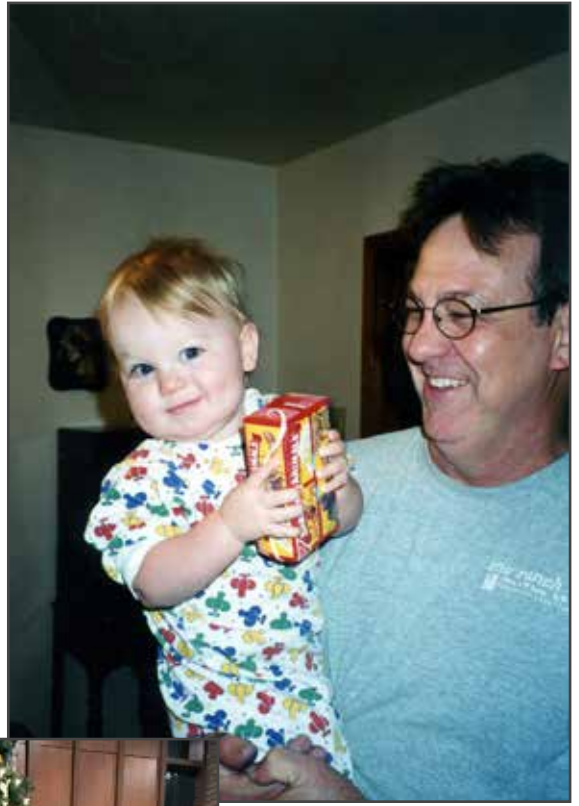
THE BROKEN CHAIN
