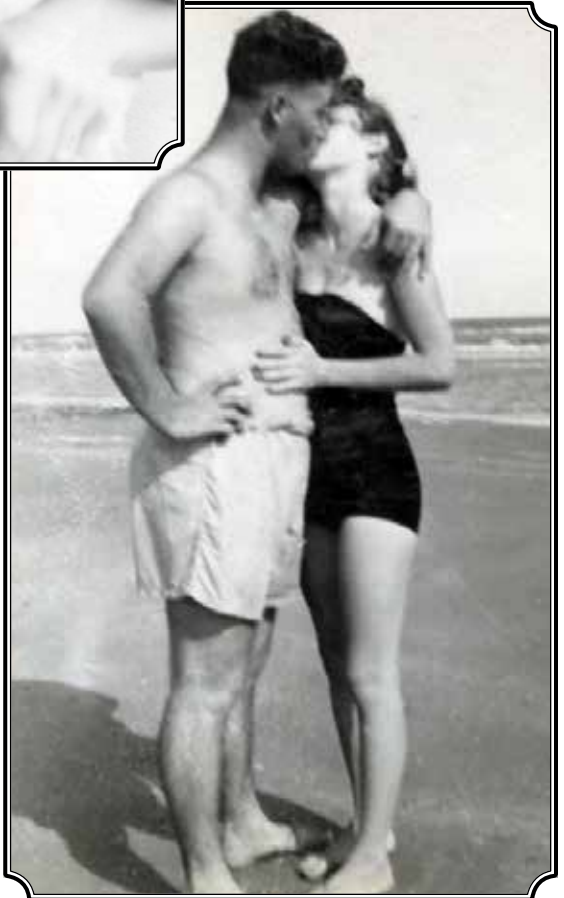

Survivors include her sons, Gary W. Amy and his wife, Laurel, of Port Arthur; Keith Amy of Groves; and

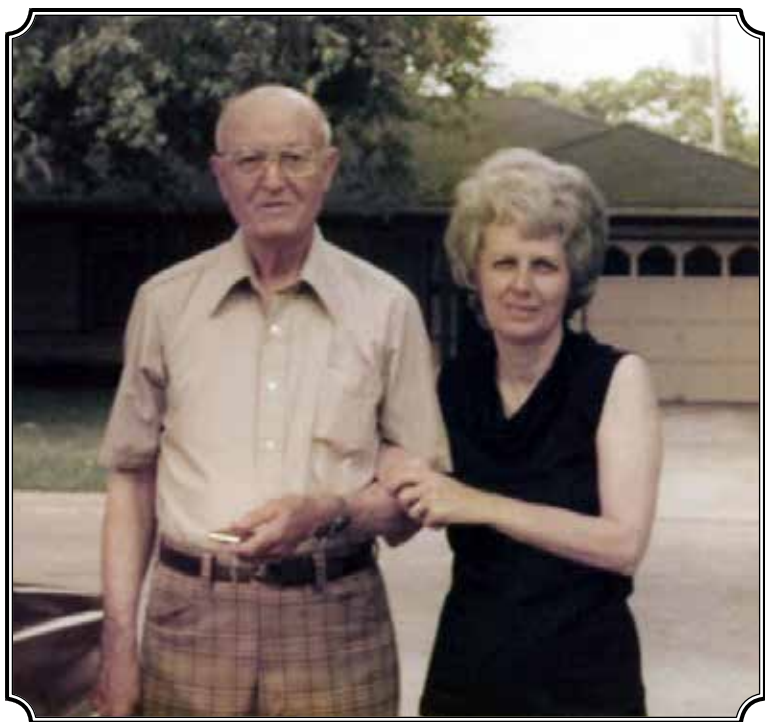

She is preceded in death by her parents; husband, Adam Wayne Amy; and brothers, James Paul Ratliff and Ronnie Ratliff.













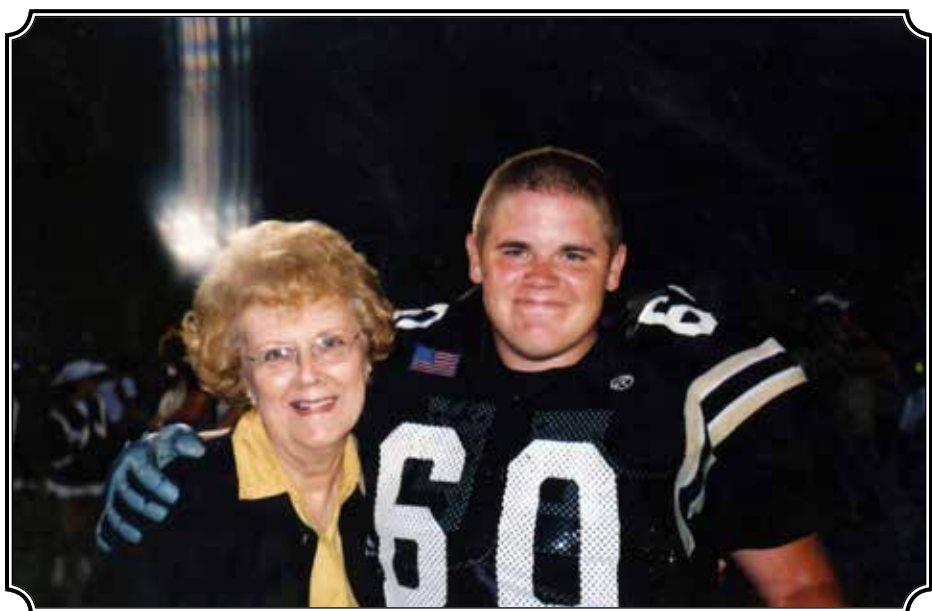
