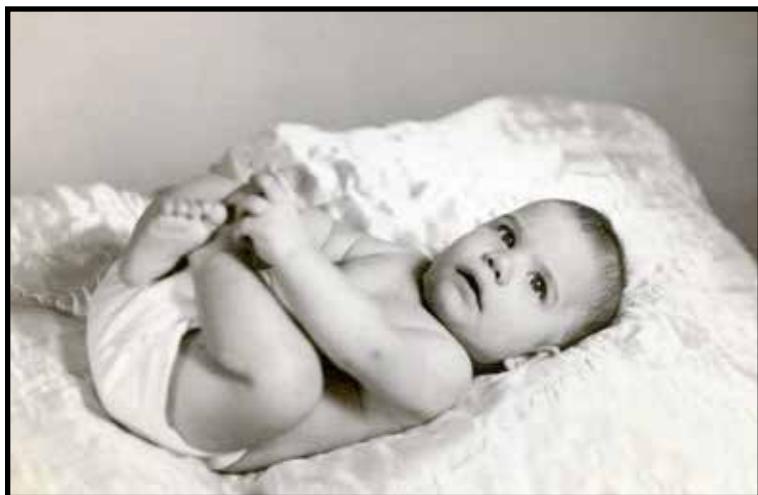

He was preceded in death by his parents, Lilly and Lewis Angelle.



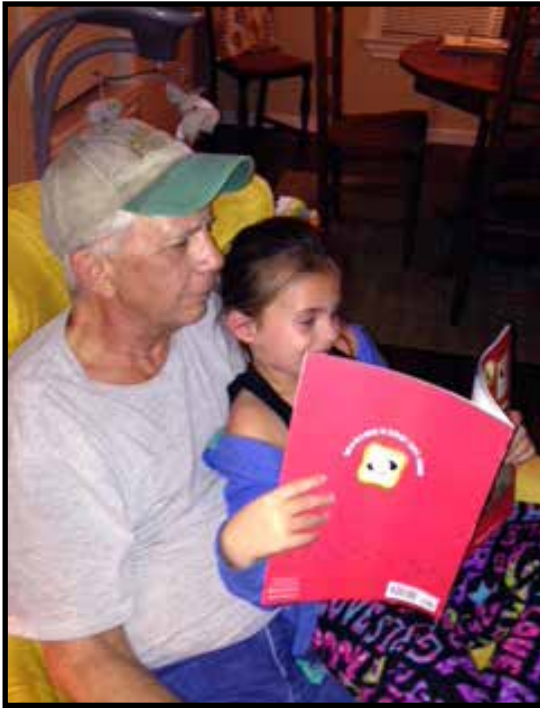
