She is preceded in death by her parents; brothers, Richard and Charles Simoneaux; and sister, Jeanette Tamplin.













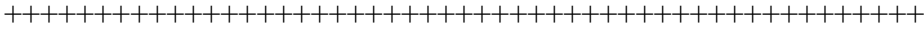




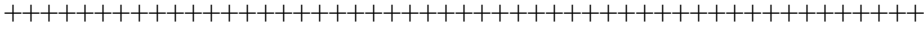
