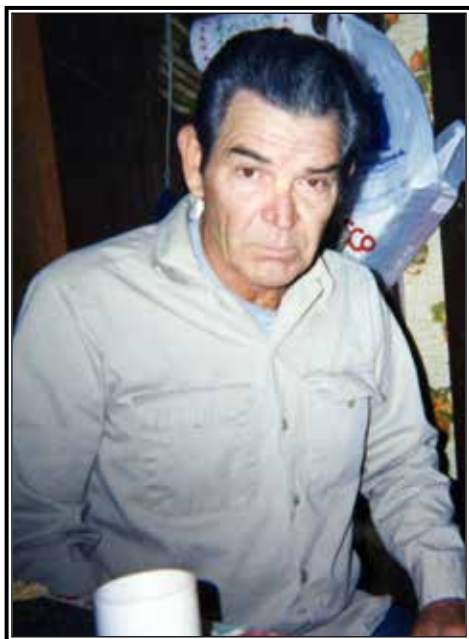

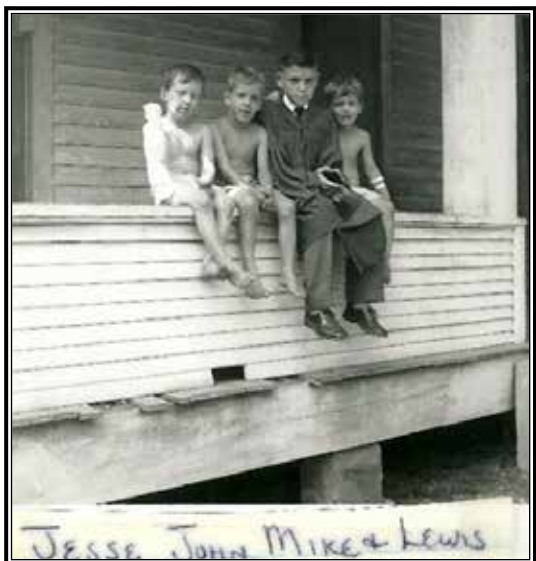
fishing, hunting, woodworking, playing cards and spending time with his family.
