July 29, 1927 - November 14, 2018

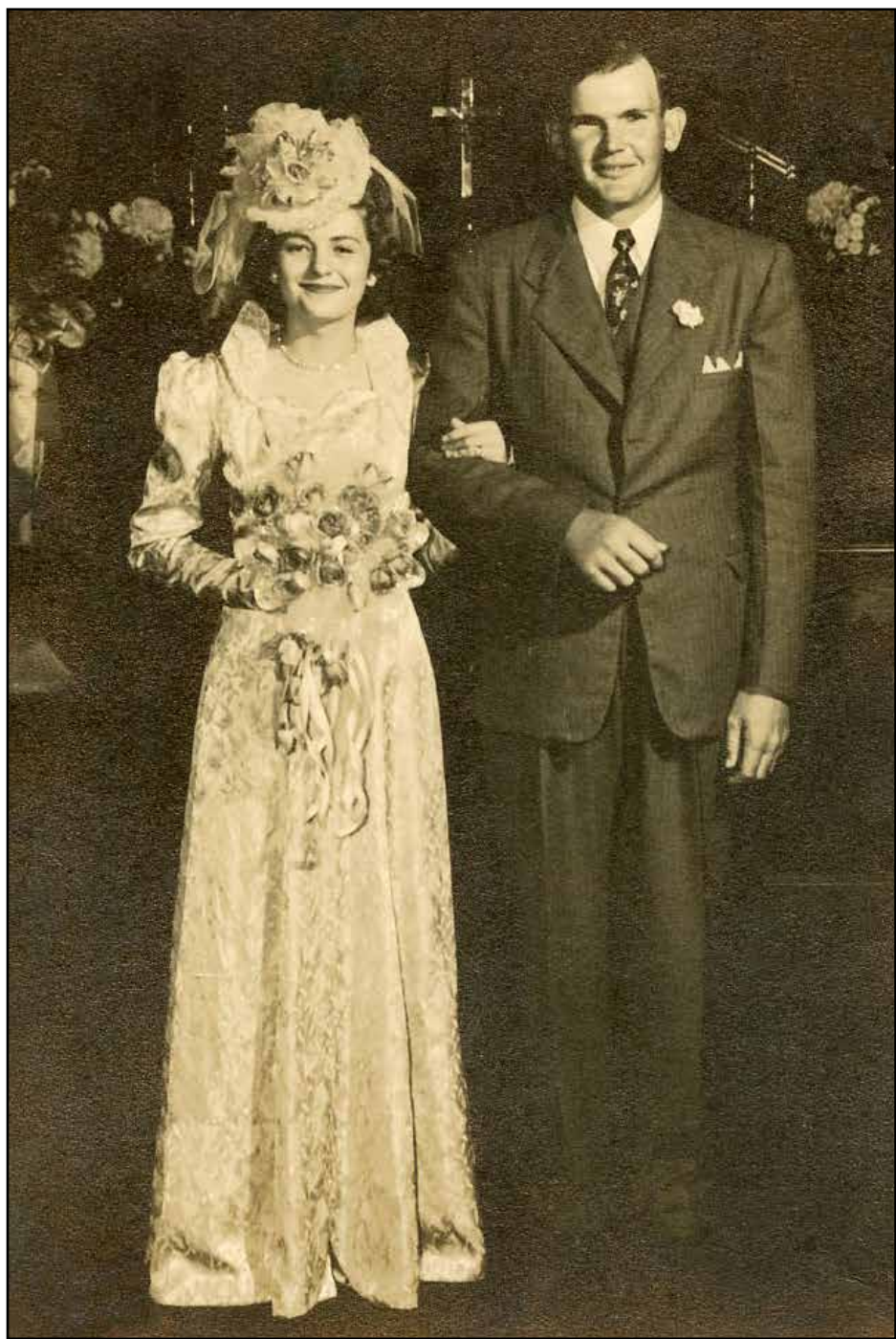
