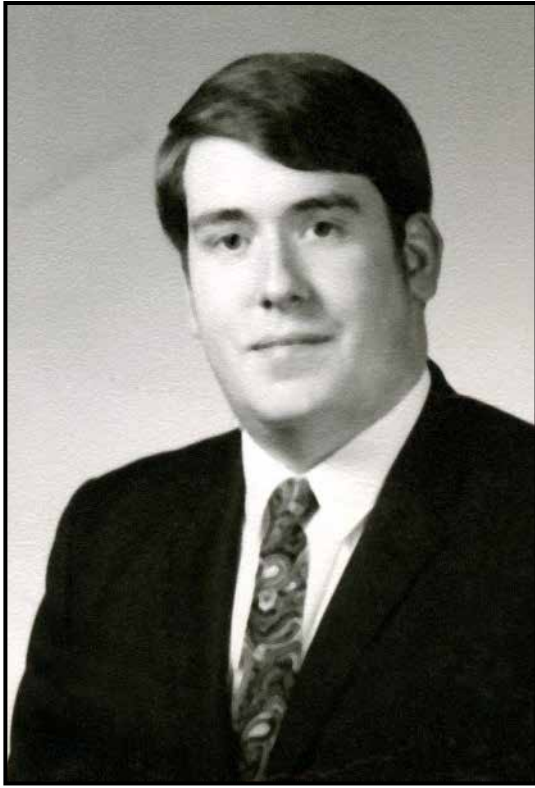


Jay Phillip Bishop, Jr.

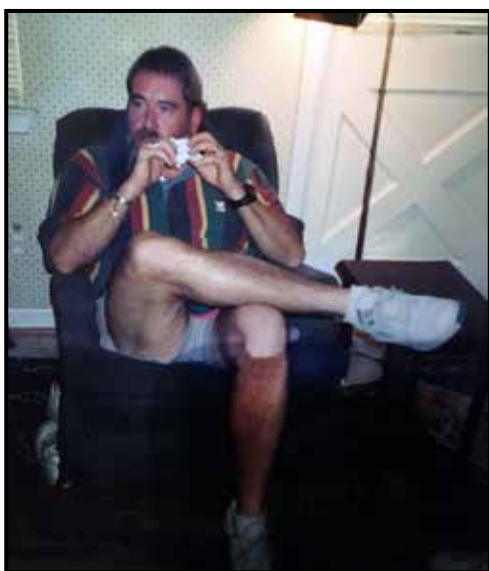

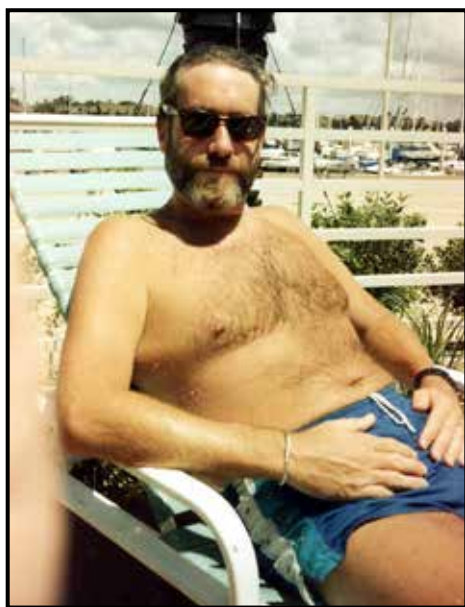
Jay is preceded in death by his parents.
