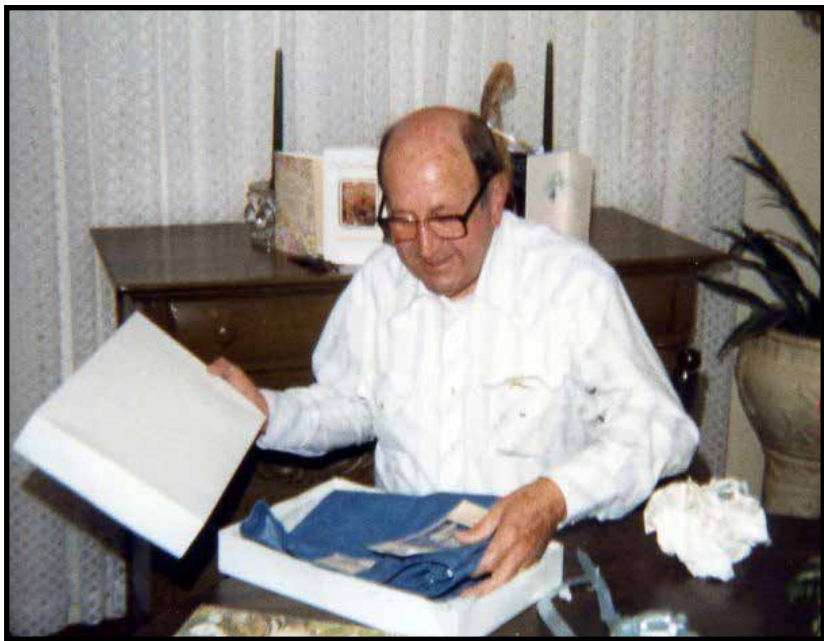

Preceded in death by parents; brother, Kenneth; and wife, Christy.







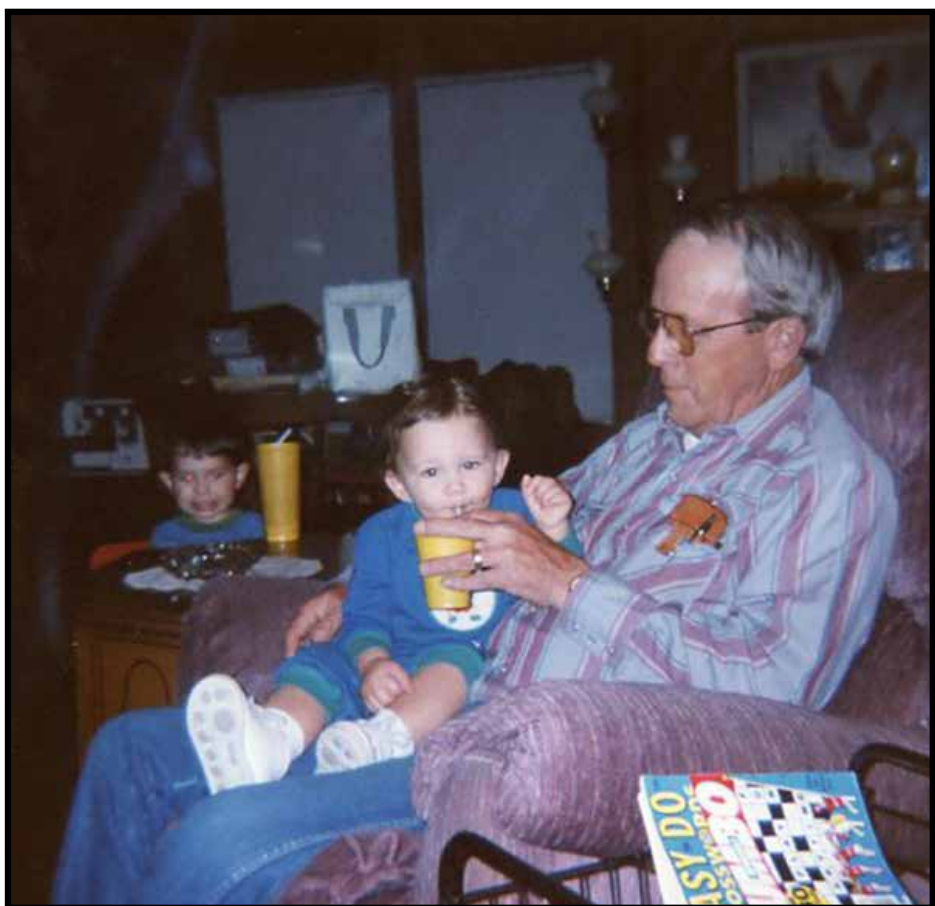
