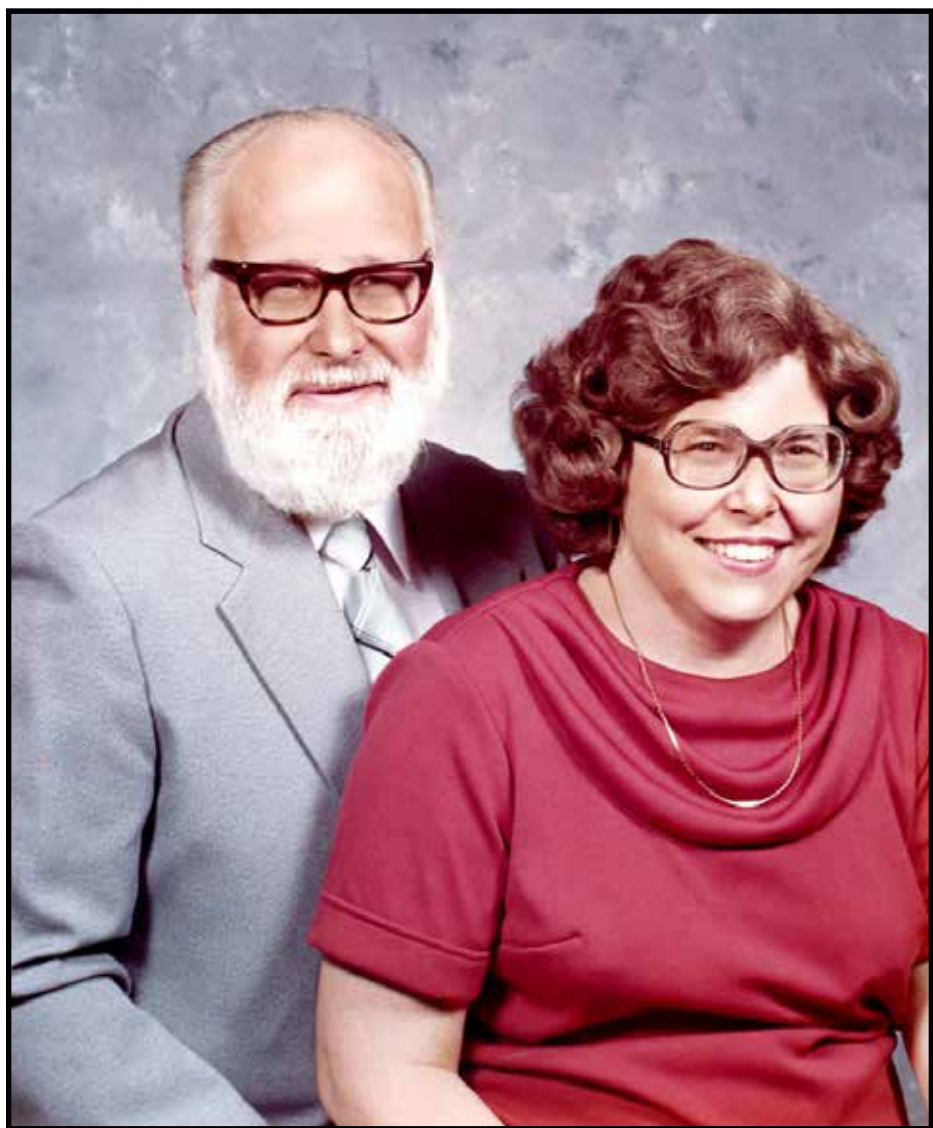
Star and was a very active member of Calvary Baptist Church until her health declined in recent years.
