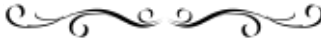

Survivors include her husband of seventy-one years, E.J. Booker, Jr.; children, Jo Carolyn Crowell

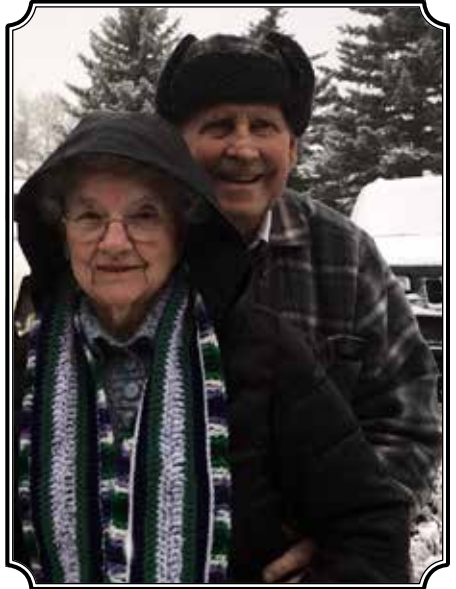
