






































When Tomorrow Starts Without Me

"I promise no tomorrow, But today will always last; And since each day's the same day, There's no longing for the past."


"But you have been so faithful, So trusting and so true; Though at times you did do things, You knew you shouldn't do."


"But you have been forgiven
