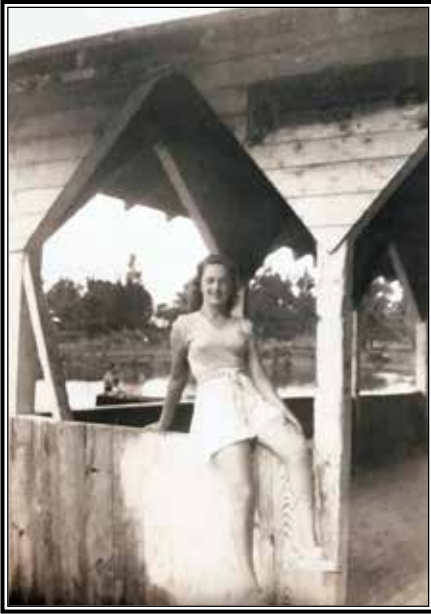
Ronnie, Gary, and Robin.

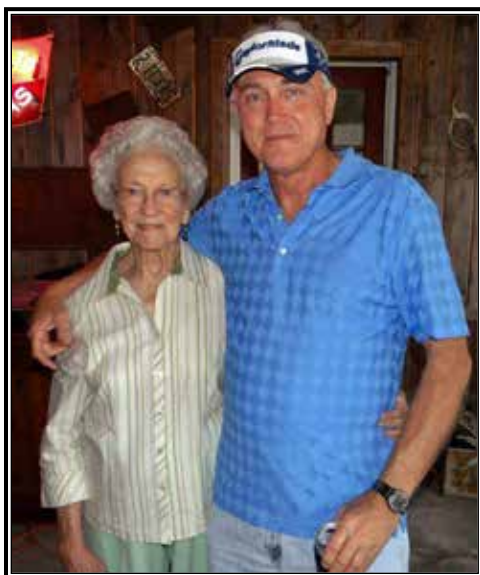














Mam-Maw's Banana Pudding

Bananas 4-5

Vanilla Wafers - 1 box

1 large or 2 small instant vanilla pudding (mix by directions)

1 large Cool Whip ($\frac{1}{2}$ in mixture, $\frac{1}{2}$ on top)

1 can Eagle Brand Condensed Milk

Mix pudding, Eagle Brand Milk, and $\frac{1}{2}$ Cool Whip together.

Put layer of vanilla wafers, then layer of bananas in 3 qt. oblong casserole dish. Pour pudding mix over top, then layer rest of cookies, bananas, and pudding until all is used. Put rest of the Cool Whip on top and put in fridge until ready to eat.
