He is preceded in death by his mother, Doris Moorner.







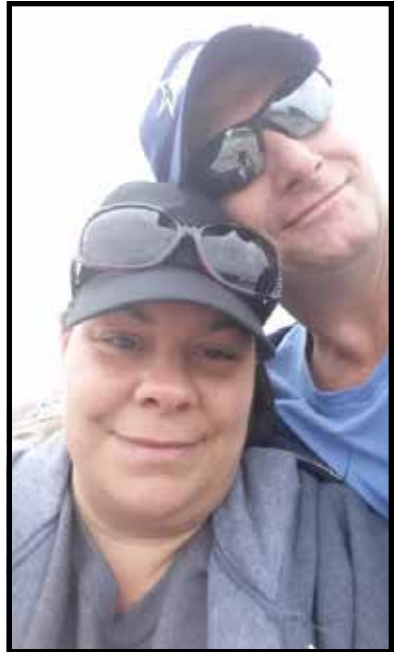
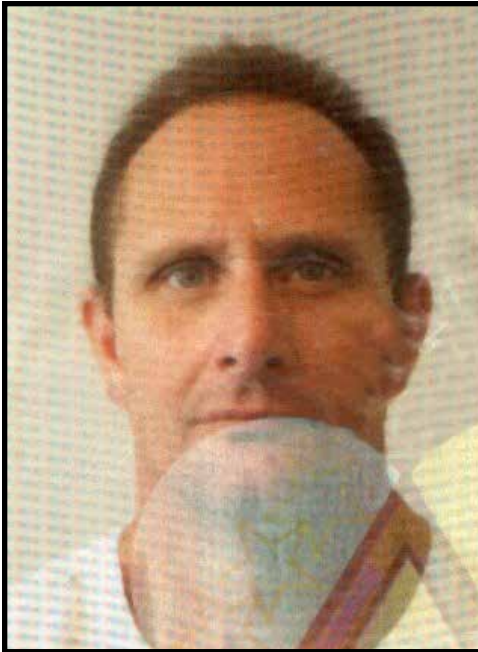




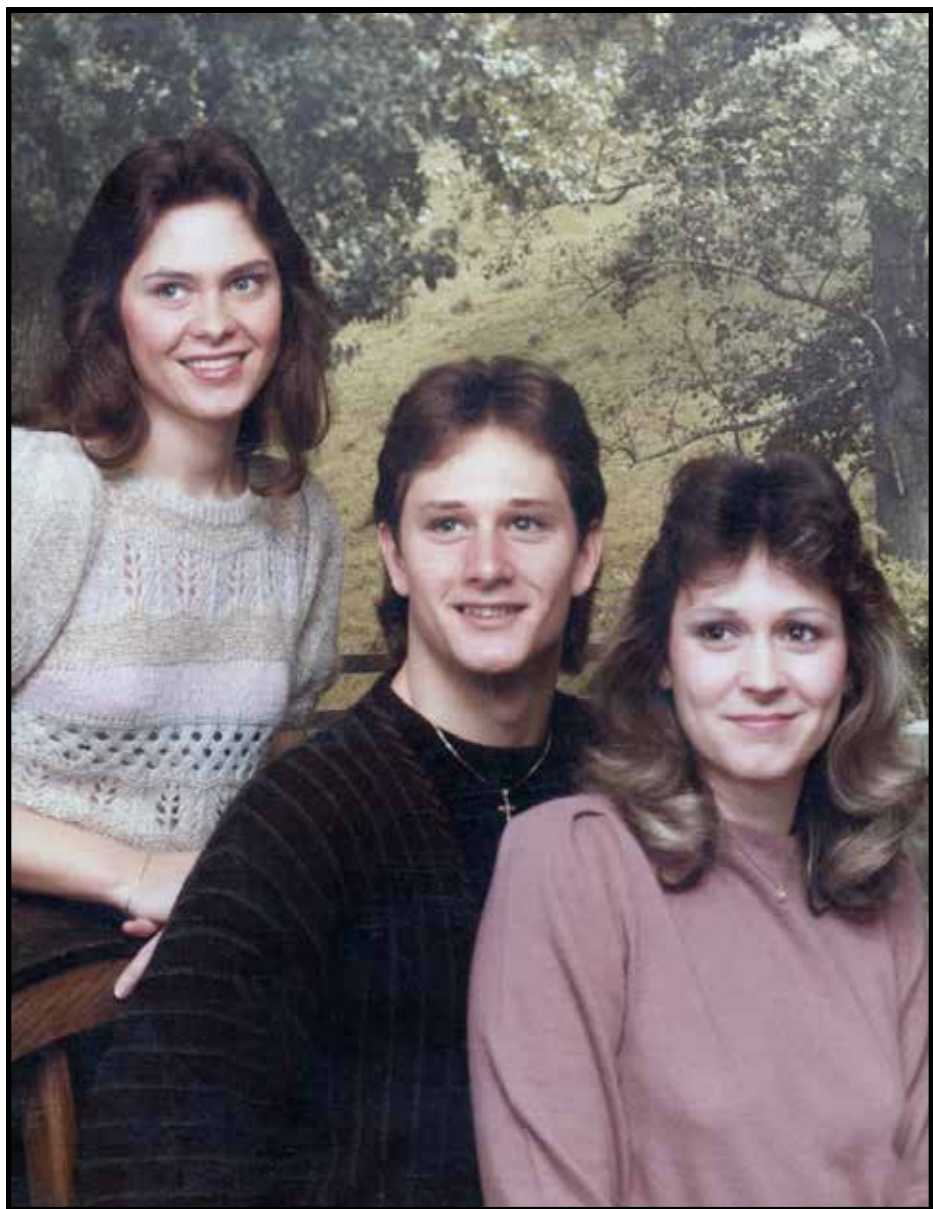
