She is preceded in death by her husband, Wilbert “Frenchie” Breaux; one sister; three brothers; and son-in-law, Harry Stuart, Sr.





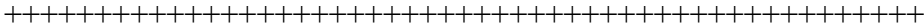




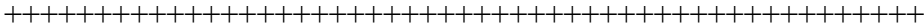
