She was preceded in death by her parents, Jennie and William Fawvor; husband, Floyd Hampton Breaux; and brother, E.C. Fawvor.





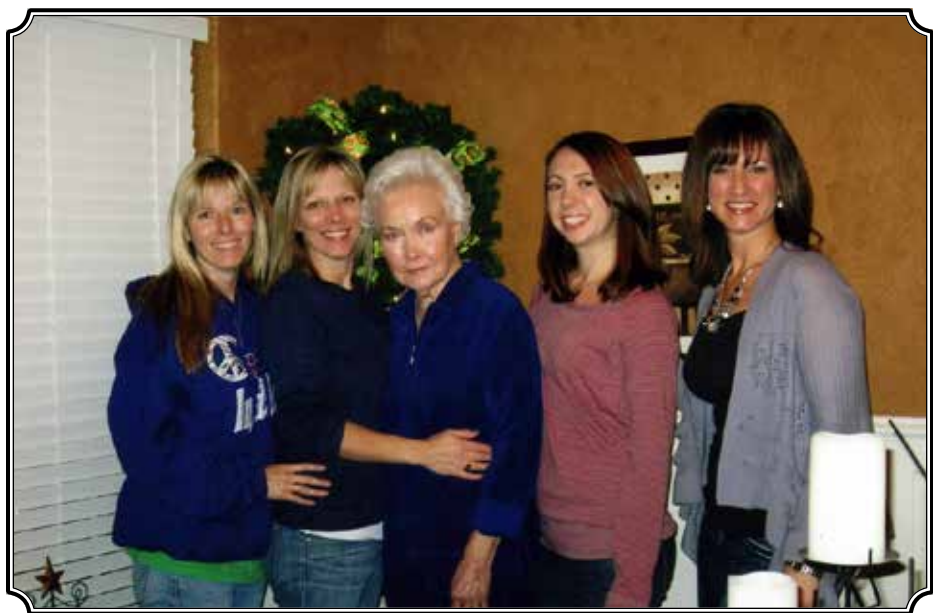
