She was preceded in death by her parents, Orville and Evelyn Bailey.



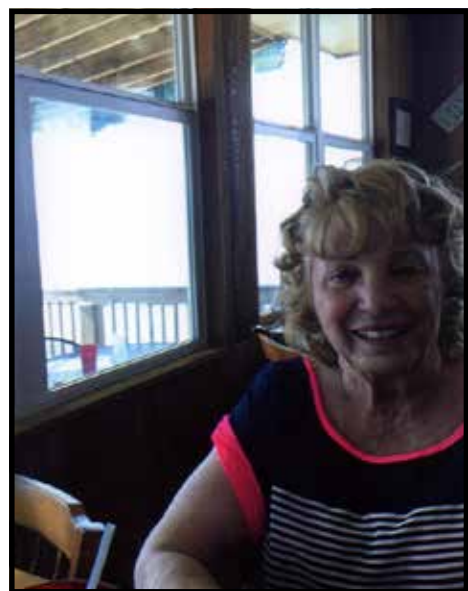
