She is preceded in death by her parents; husband, Roy Charles Broussard; sons, David and Michael Broussard; and daughter, Lisa Broussard.

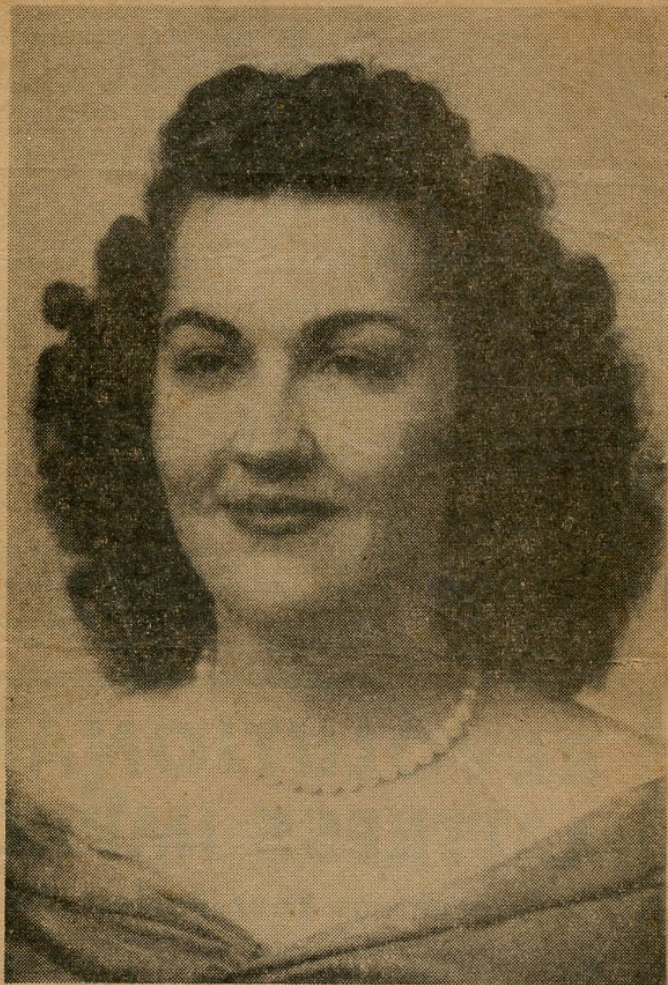








Approaching Marriage of Marjorie Easley To Roy Broussard Is Made Known Today
