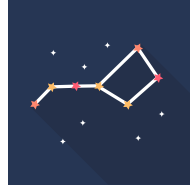
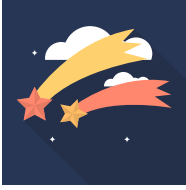












*It's time to say goodbye
