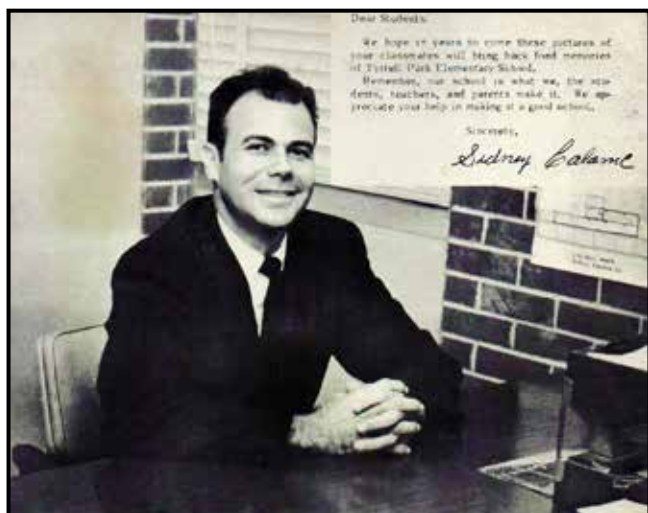

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Dickie Jane Ramsey; brother, Franklin Calame; sister-in-law, Juanita DeJarnette.









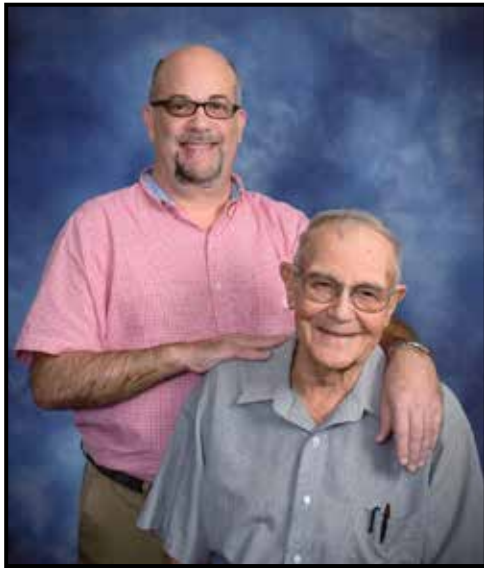
