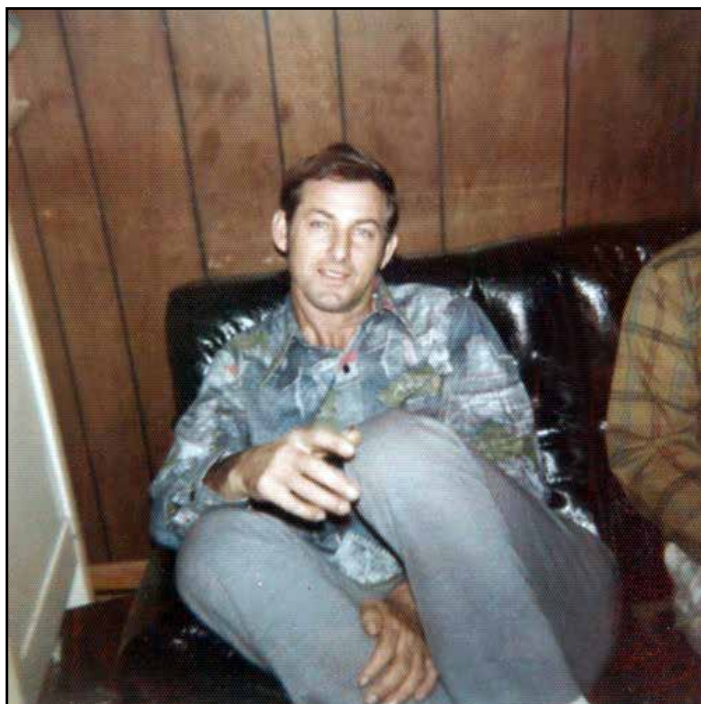

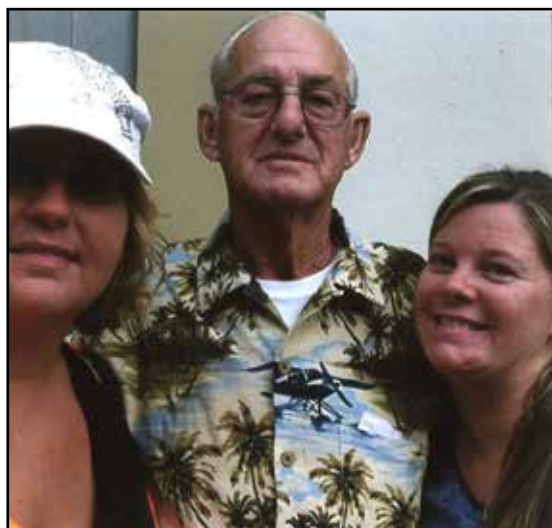














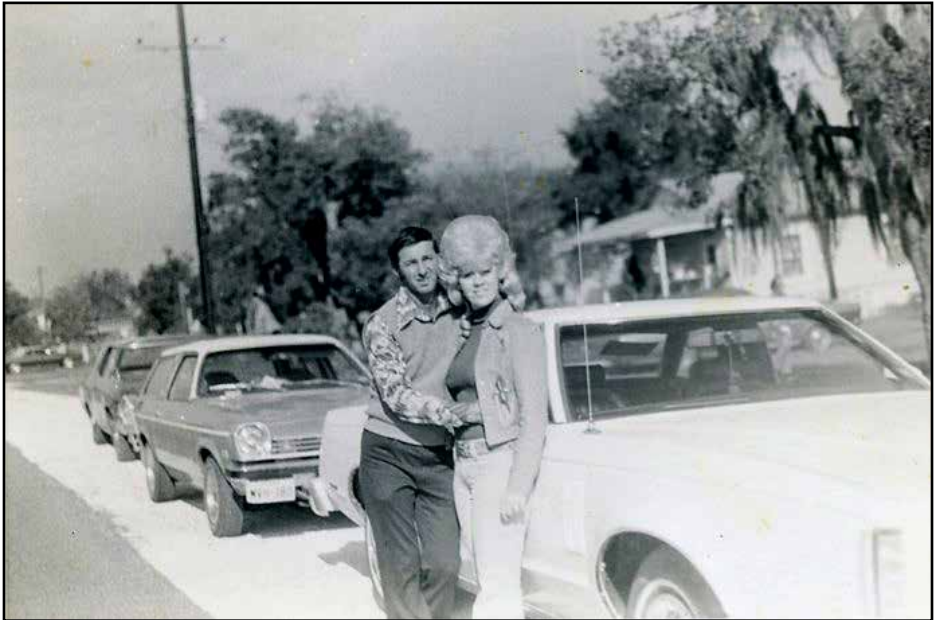






***Gone Fishing***
