He was preceded in death by his parents; and brother, Elzie "Sonny" Chambers.



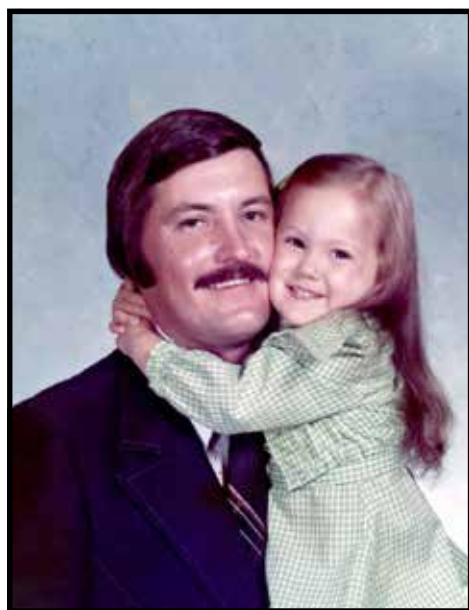
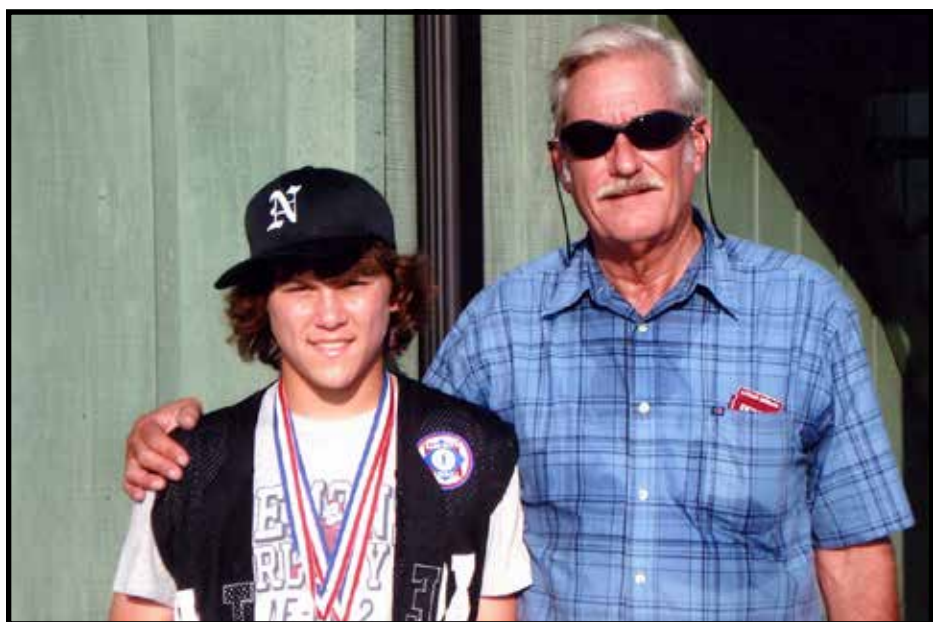




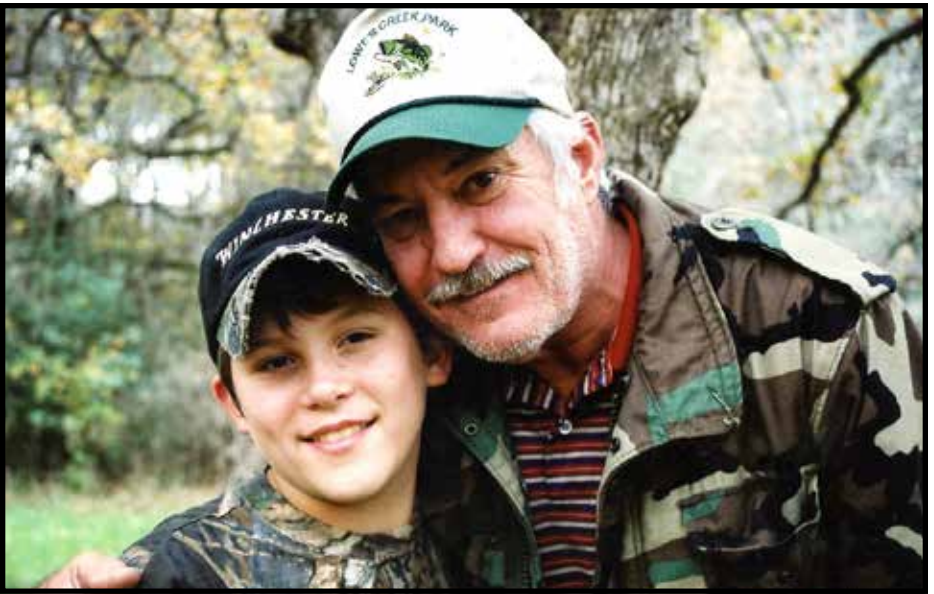












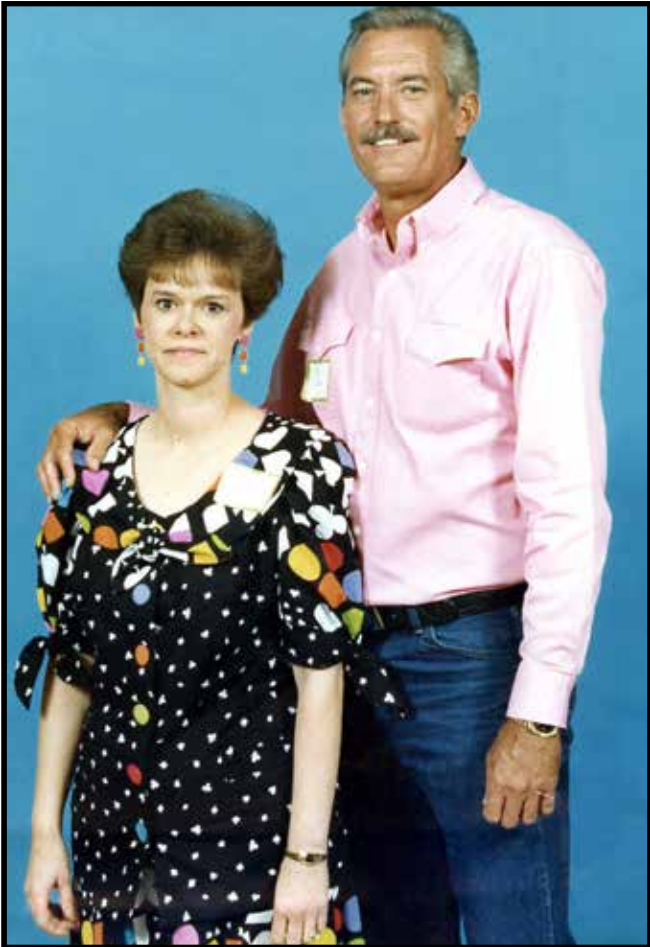


Dear PawPaw,
