In addition to his mother and father, Greg was preceded in death by his daughter, Lauren Coco.







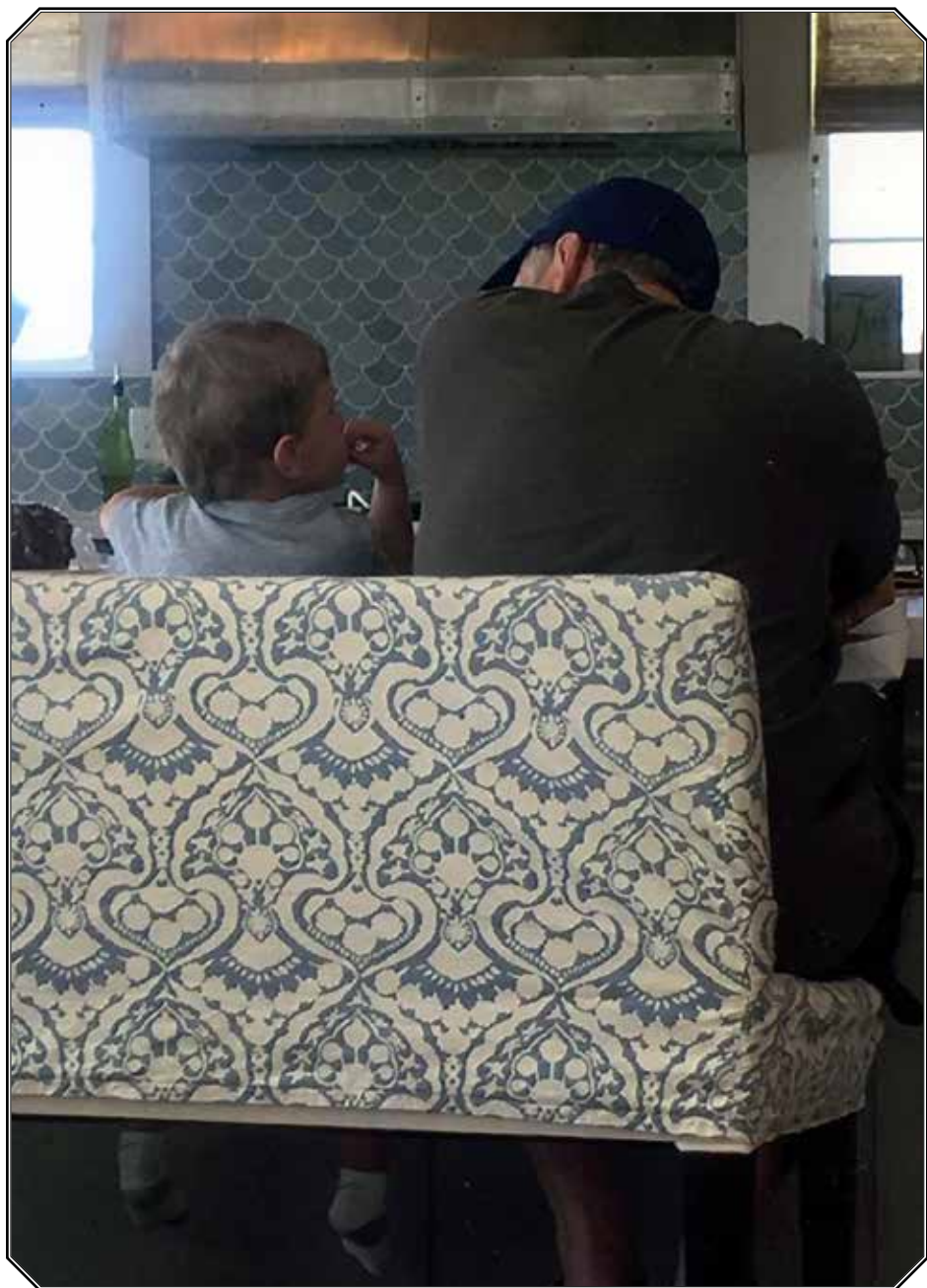


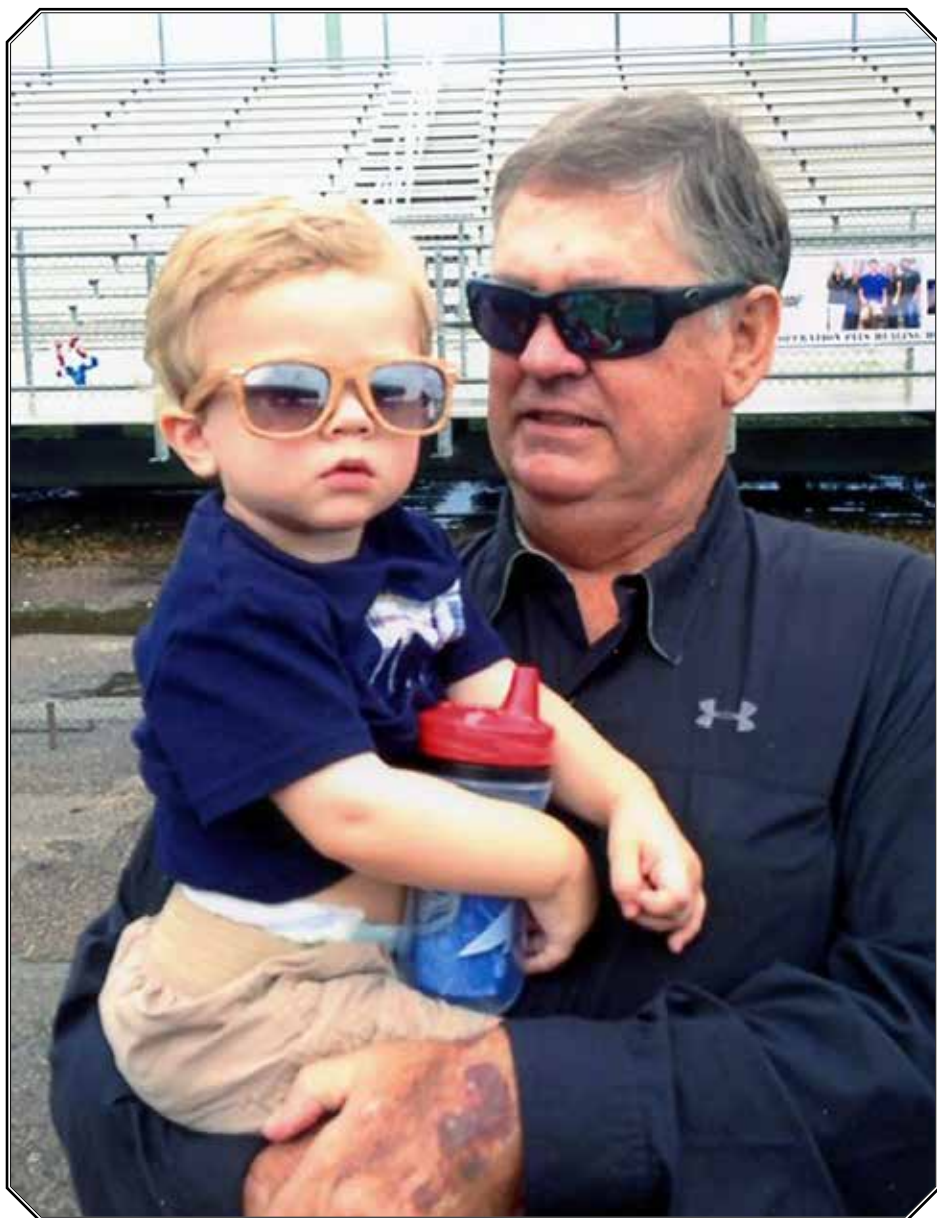






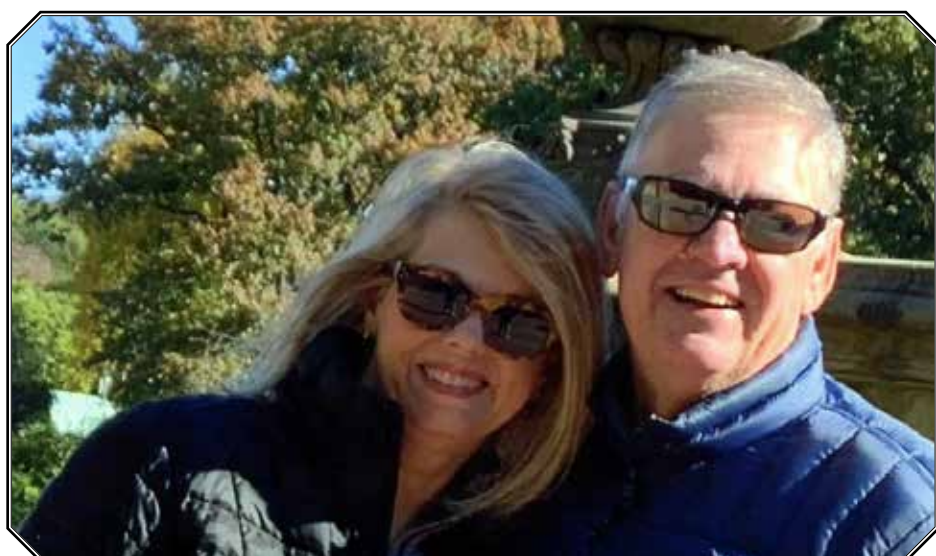
