John was able to give a gift one last time through organ donation.







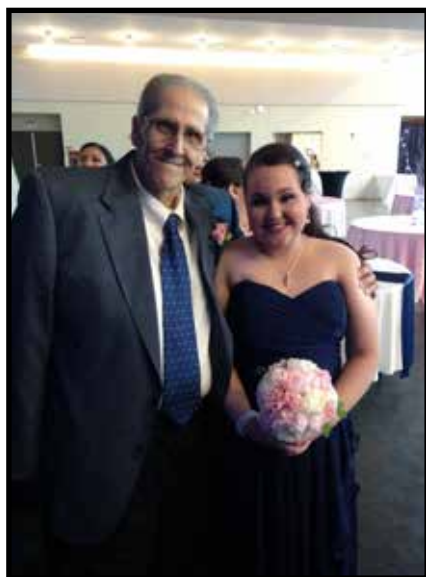

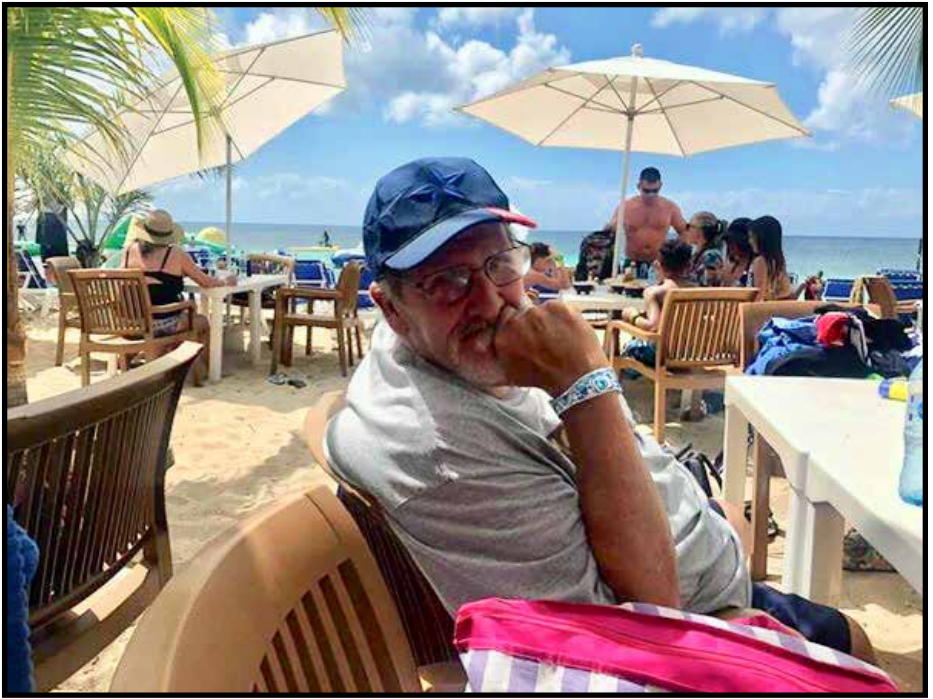
