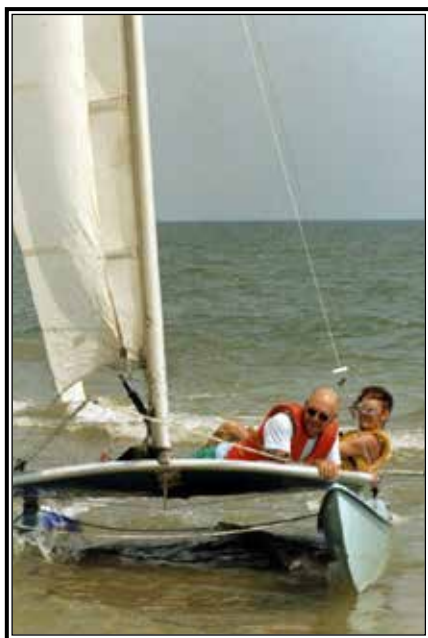
Tom was excellent at woodwork, custom cabinets, and furniture. He enjoyed drag racing, and occasionally did a little oil painting.
