He is preceded in death by his parents; brother, Keith Cormier; and grandson, Kasey Cormier.

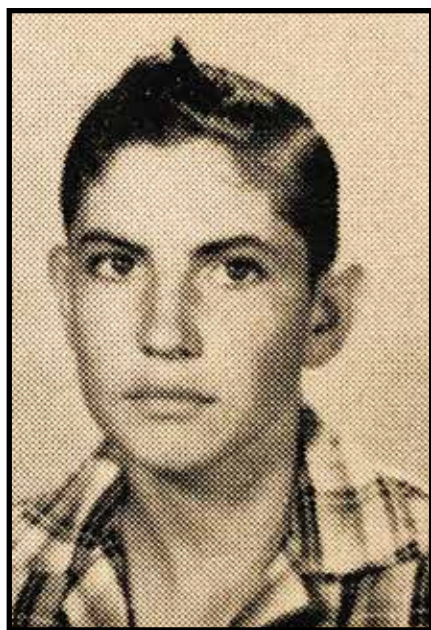
The Twenty-Third Psalm

will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

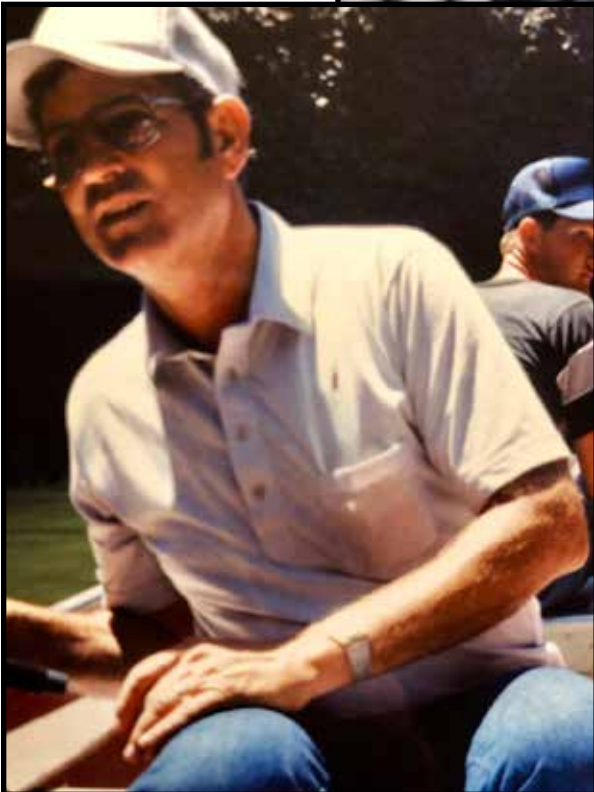




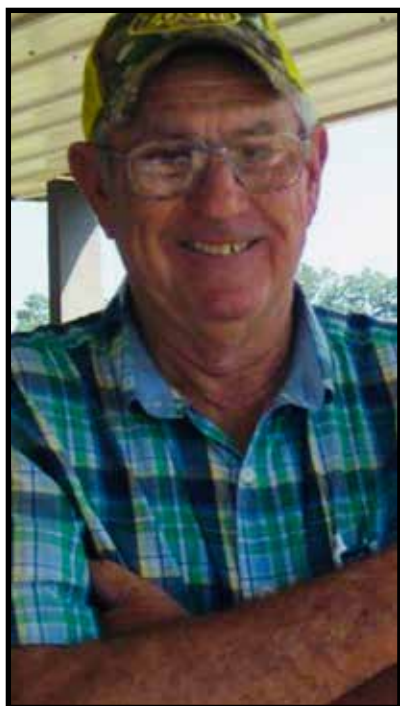
