The family would like to thank Intrepid Home Health, specifically Sylvia Anandel and Judy Trejo, for the excellent care they gave our dad.

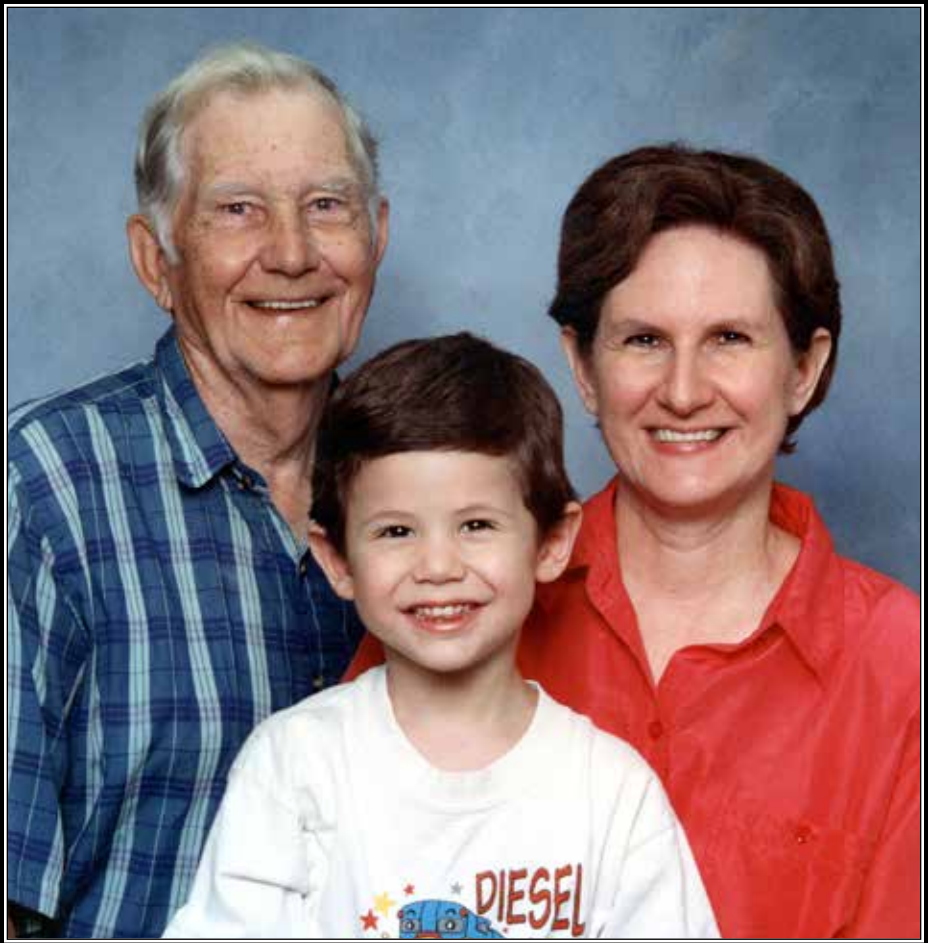
