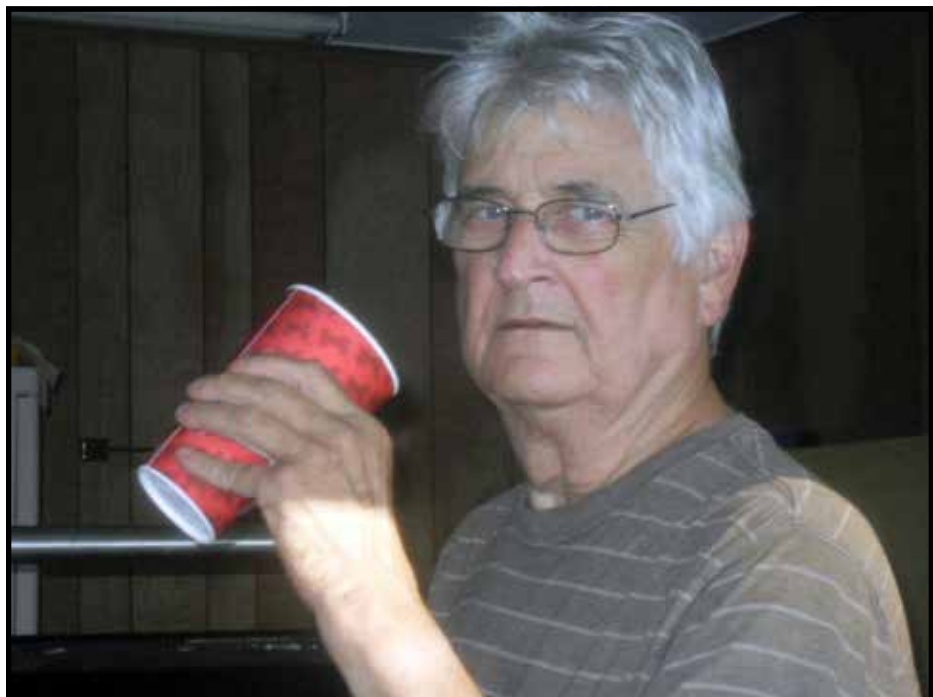
Michael was a United States Air Force veteran. He retired as a Supervisor from Huntsman.
