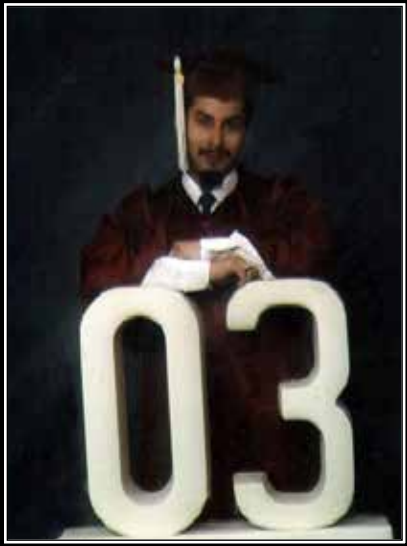
He also loved animals and was known as the “cat whisperer” because of his fondness for cats.

He is preceded in death by his grandparents, Marcella R. DeLuna, Juan DeLuna, Sr., and Benito Buentello, Sr.

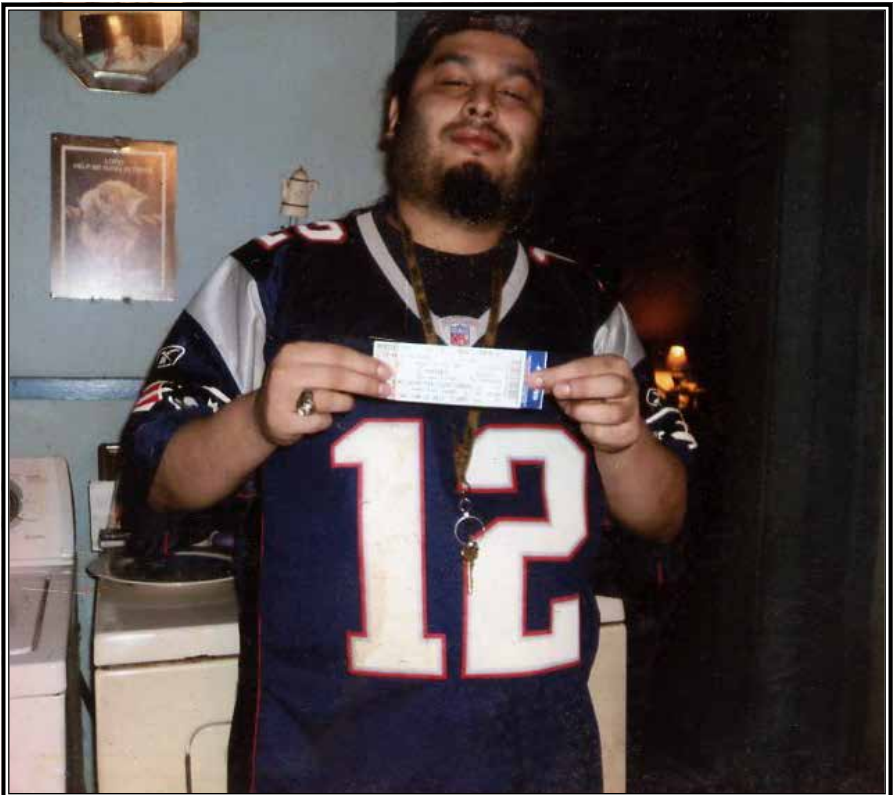


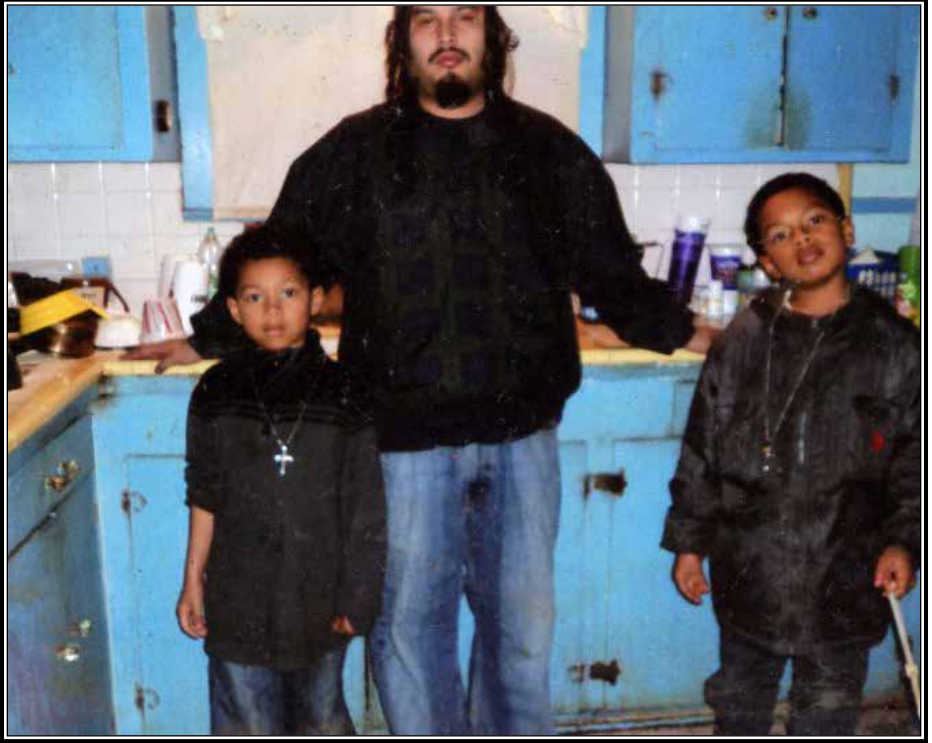
