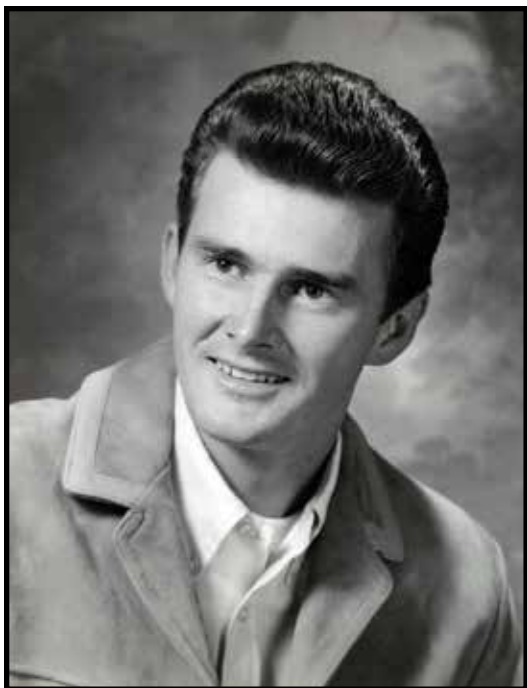

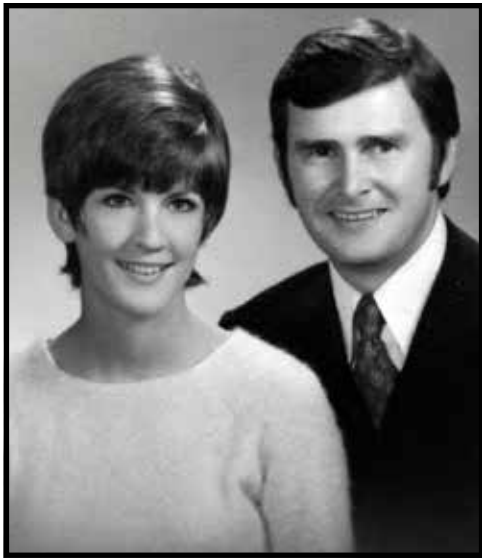
Survivors include his son, Justin DuBose and his wife, Bridget; daughter, Kindal Peltier and her

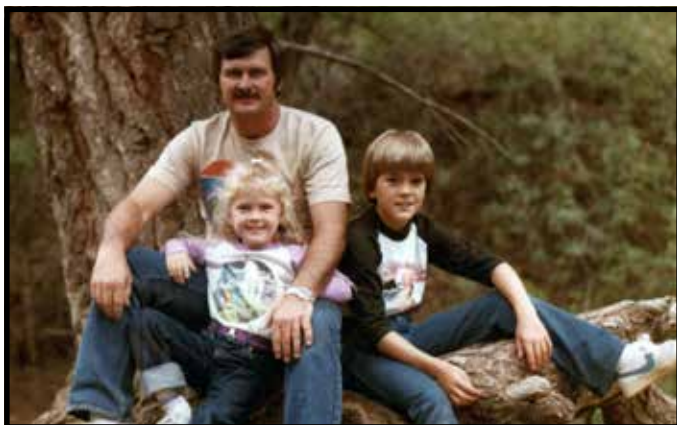
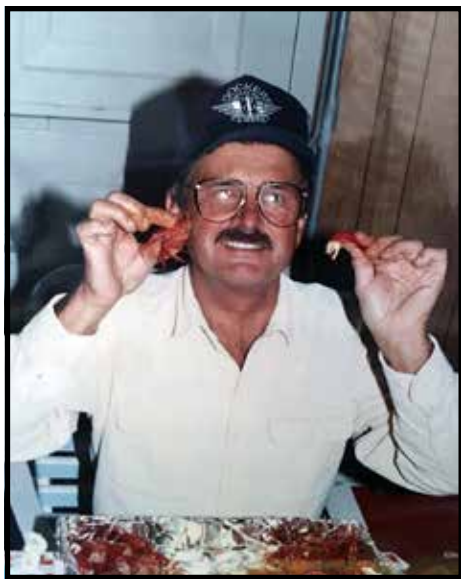
He is preceded in death by his parents and wife of forty-four years, Linda Bosse DuBose.









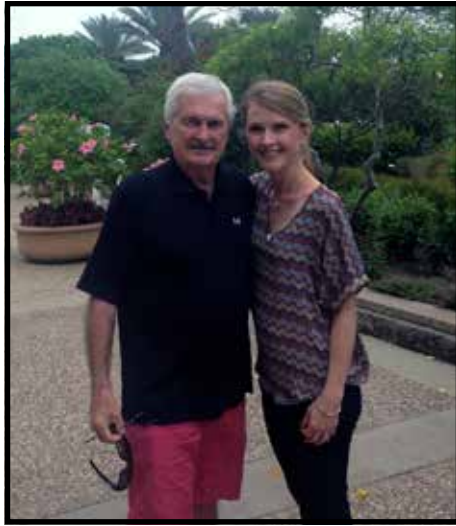
