She was past Vice President of the Texas Association of Realtors and a premiere Re/Max broker/owner in

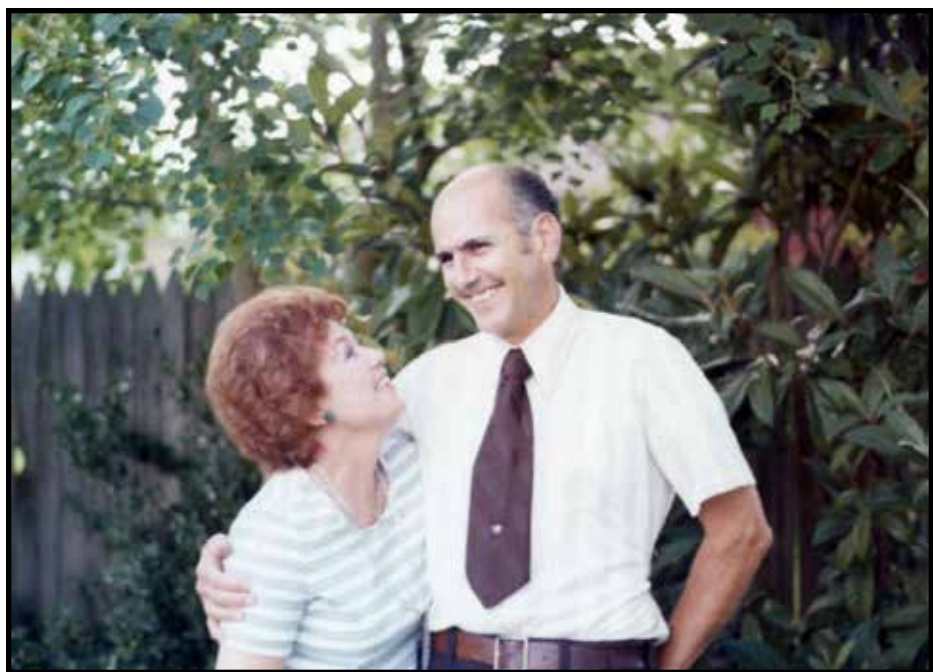

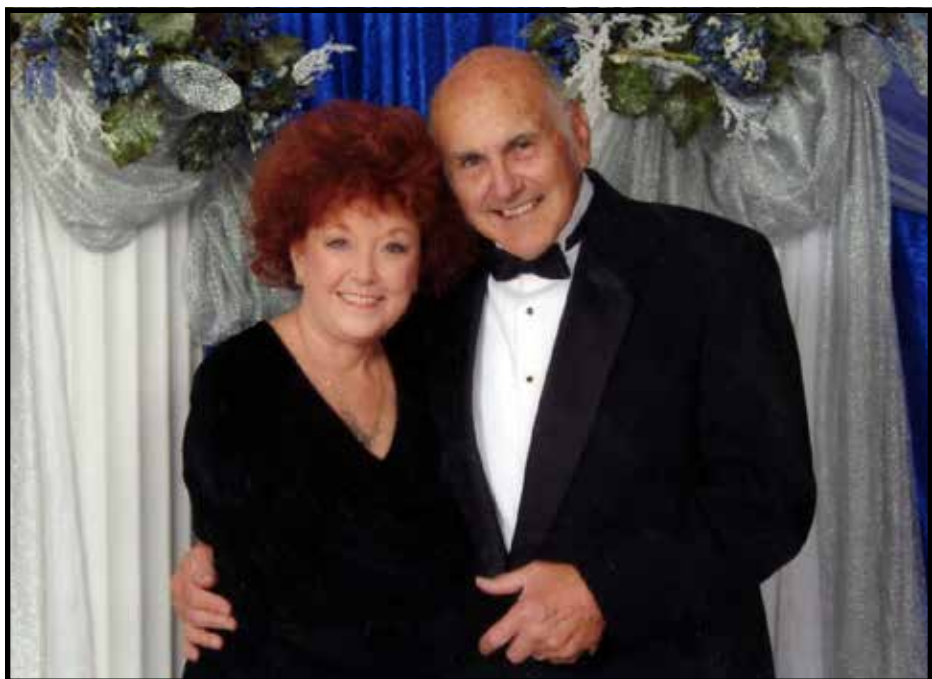

will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.*

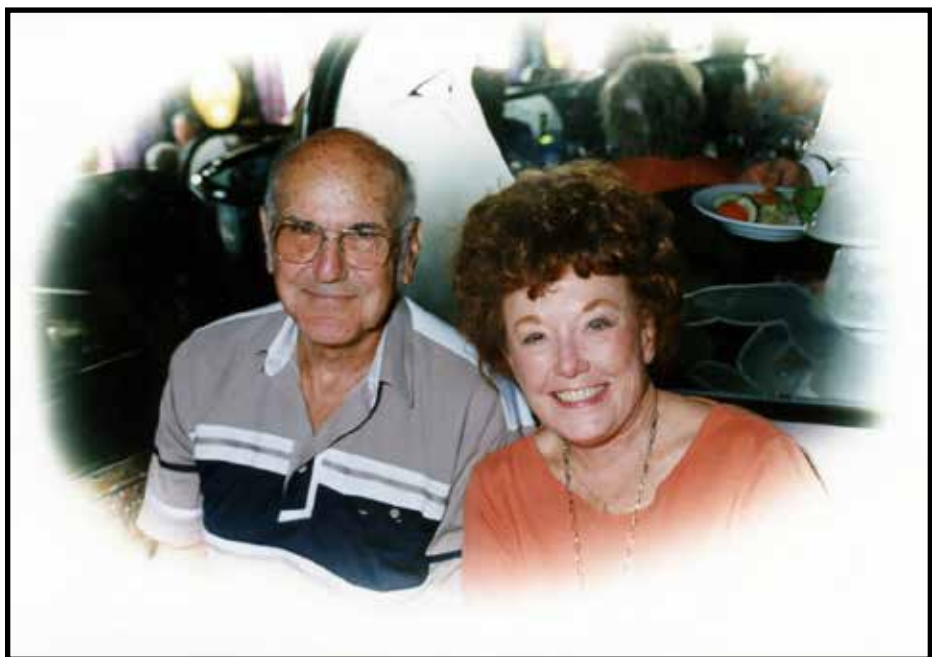
