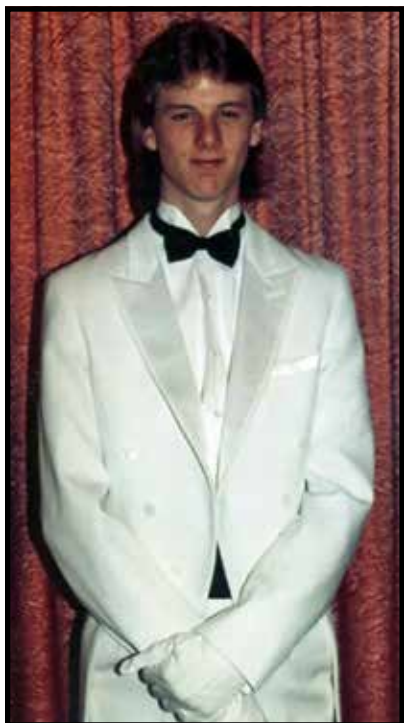

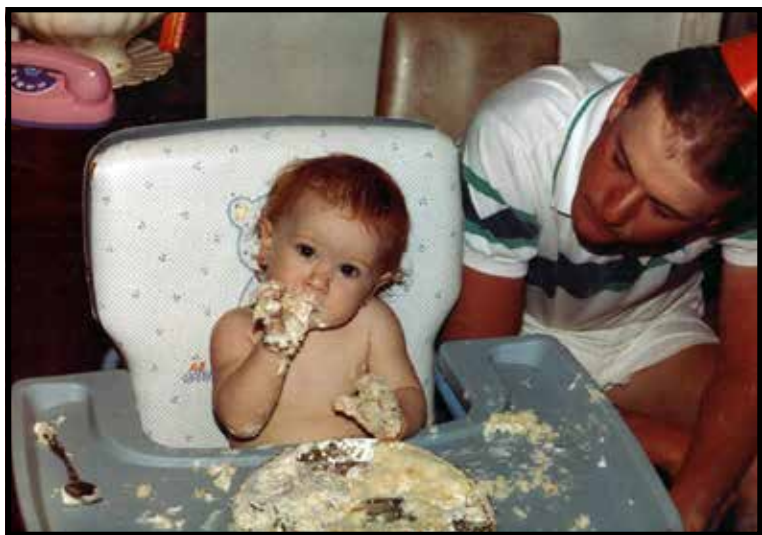

Robert is preceded in death by his father, M.J. Duke; son, Johnathan Duke; and sister-in-law, Dianne Duke.

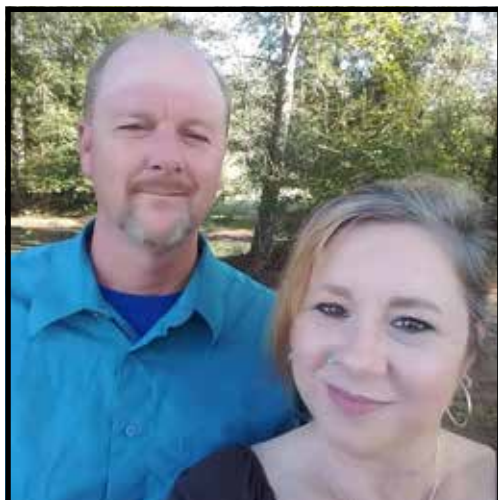










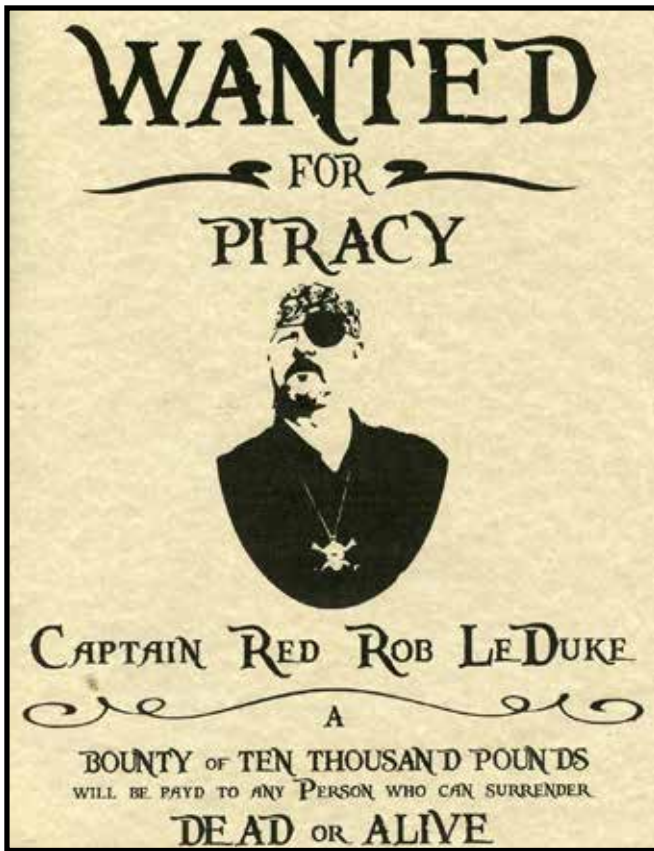
