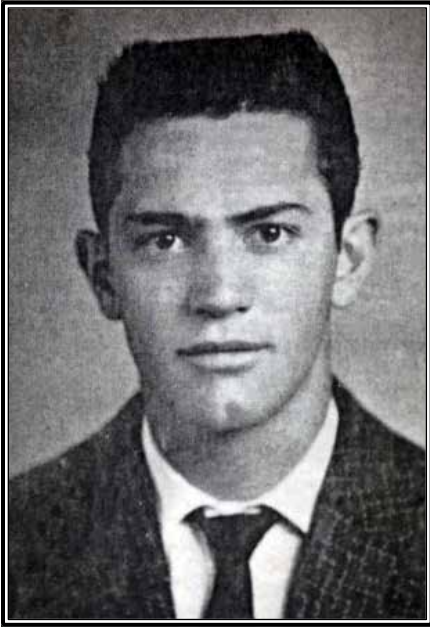

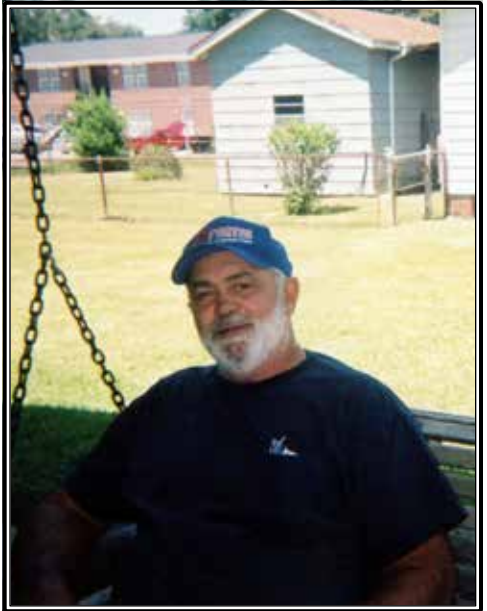

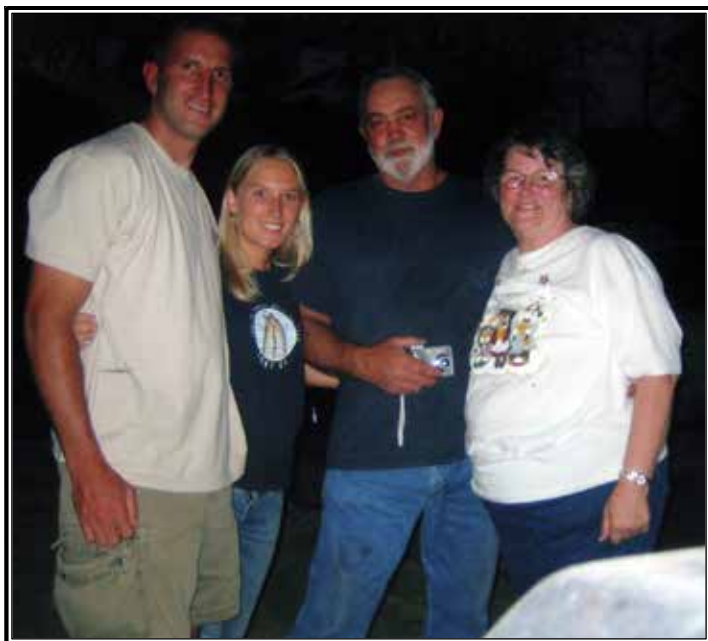
Survivors include his wife of almost fifty-three years, Enda Elliott; children, Michael Wayne

He is preceded in death by his parents; brother, Ricky Elliott; and sister, Marsha Kay Courts.

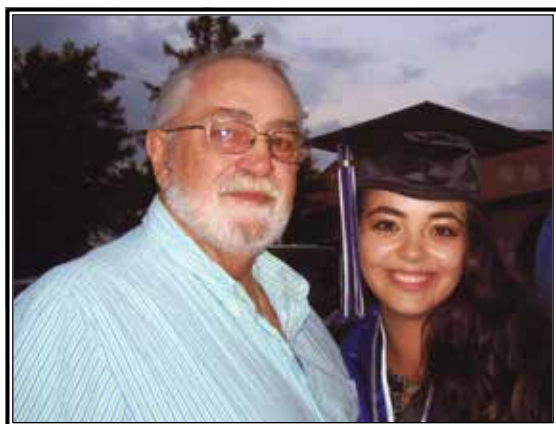
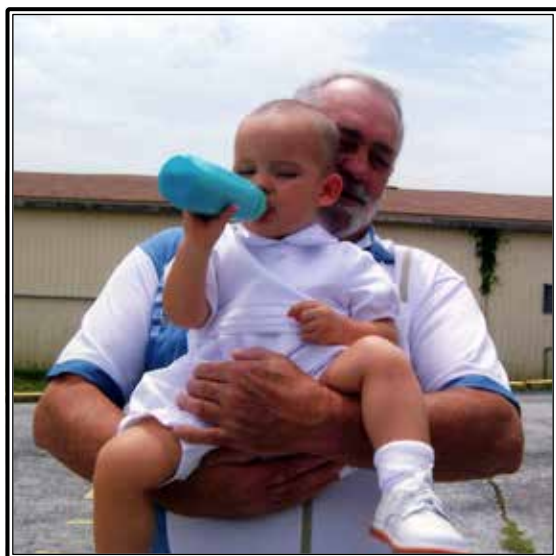




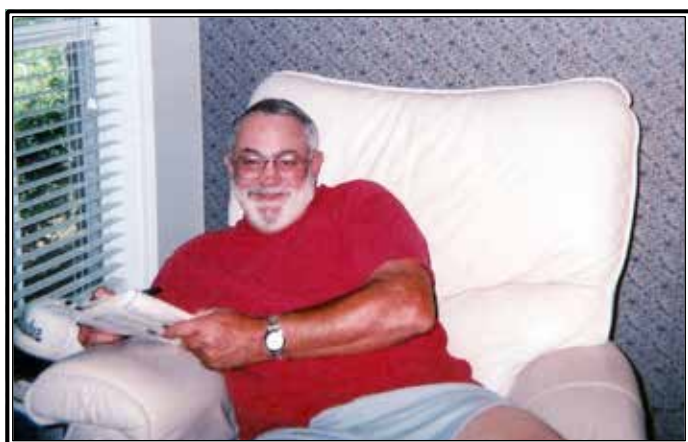
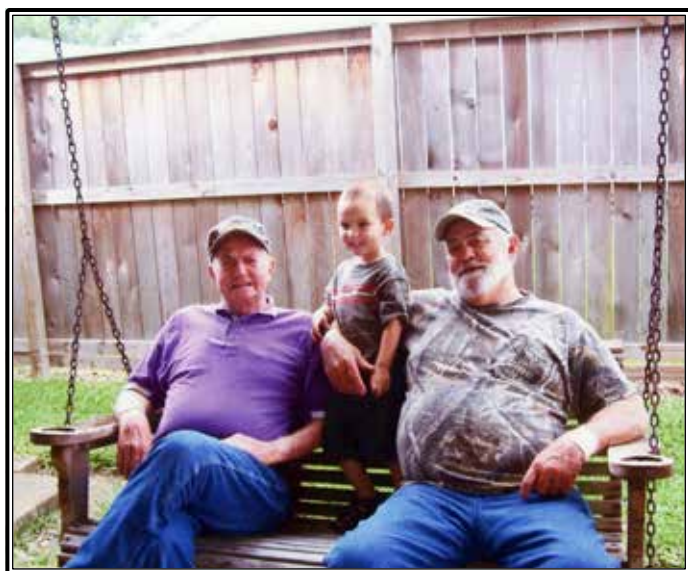


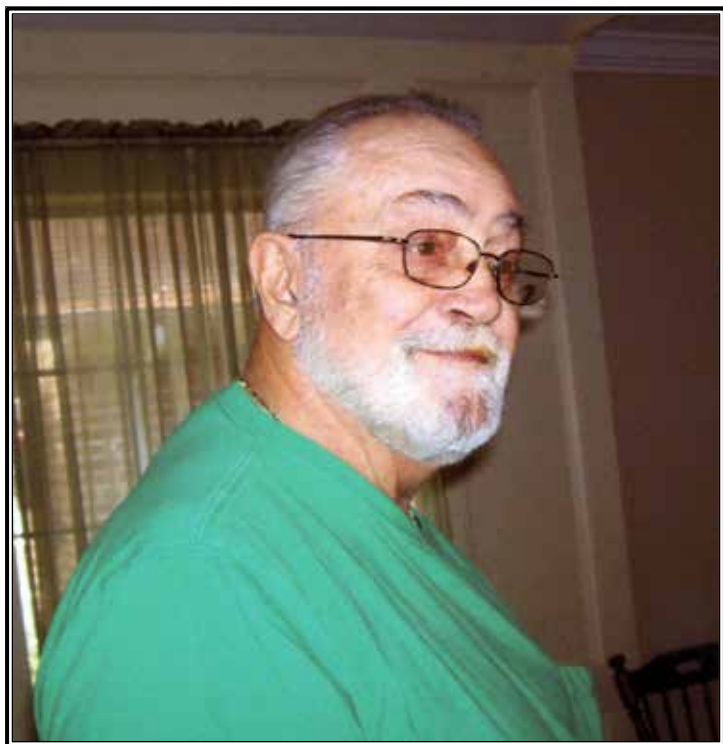
