‘bear’ hugs, he never met a stranger.

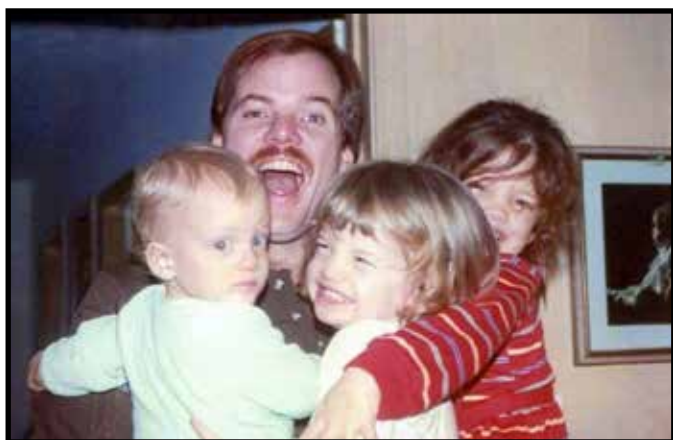

He is preceded in death by his parents, William “Pete” Elliott and Judith “Judy” Jones.







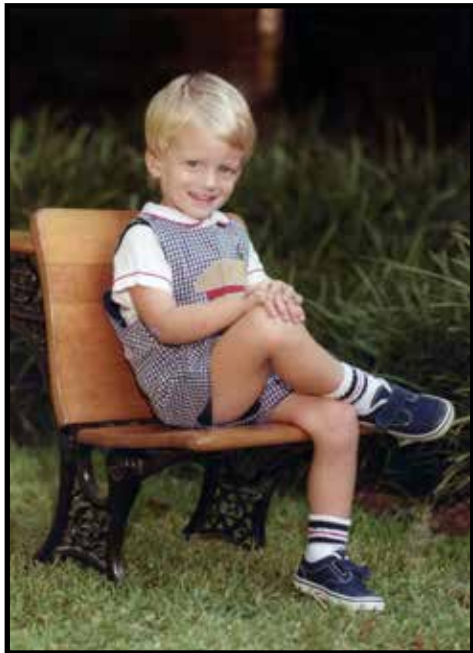
