He is preceded in death by his parents, Margaret and Wilbur Fight; and wife, Beverly Maria Fabre Fight.

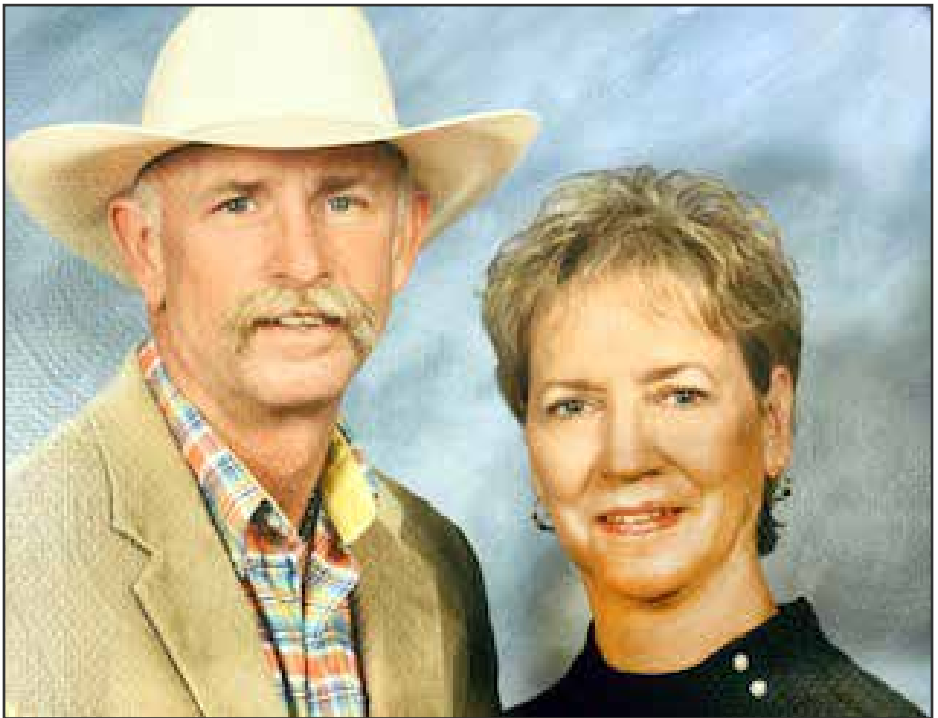
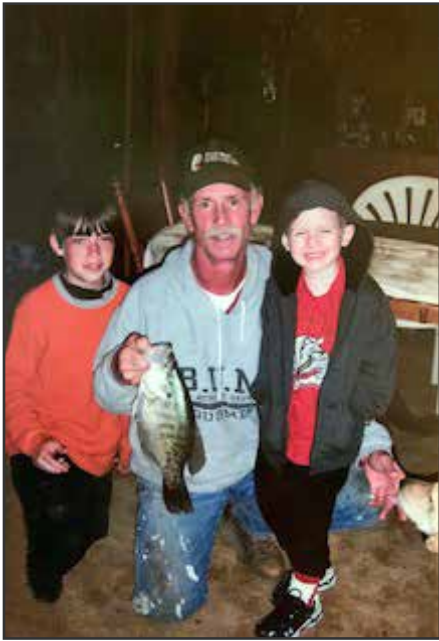
