Glennie loved her grandchildren, church, and playing piano and organ. She was very active at the Booty Ritter Senior Citizens Center.


Survivors include her son, Gregory Daniel Friesz and his wife, Shanna; daughter, Glenna



She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Gerald Daniel Friesz; brothers, Weldon, Lewis Everett; and sister, Velma Jean.











