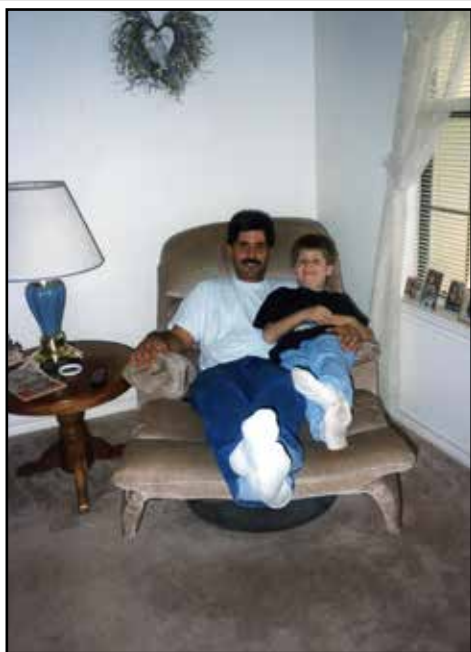
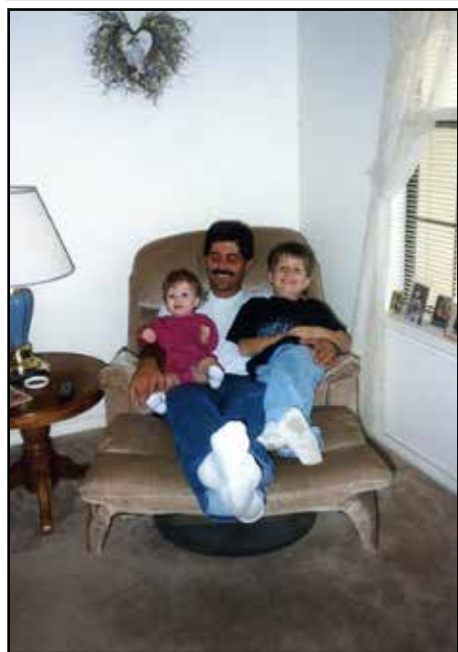
He is preceded in death by his father, Jerry Buchanan Fulfer.



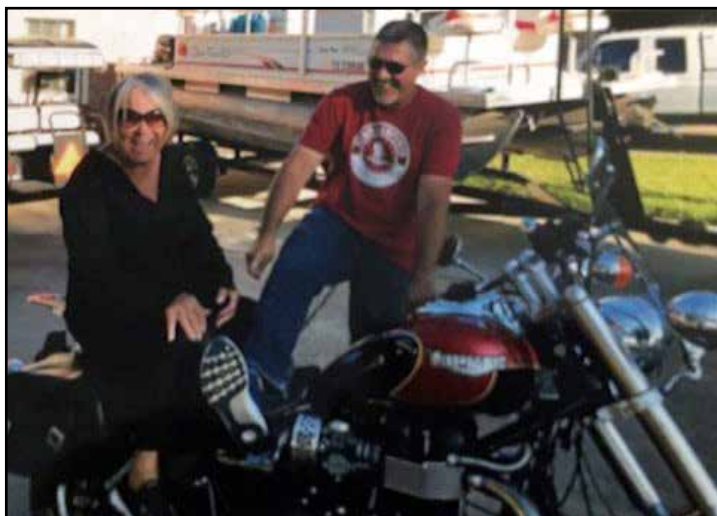
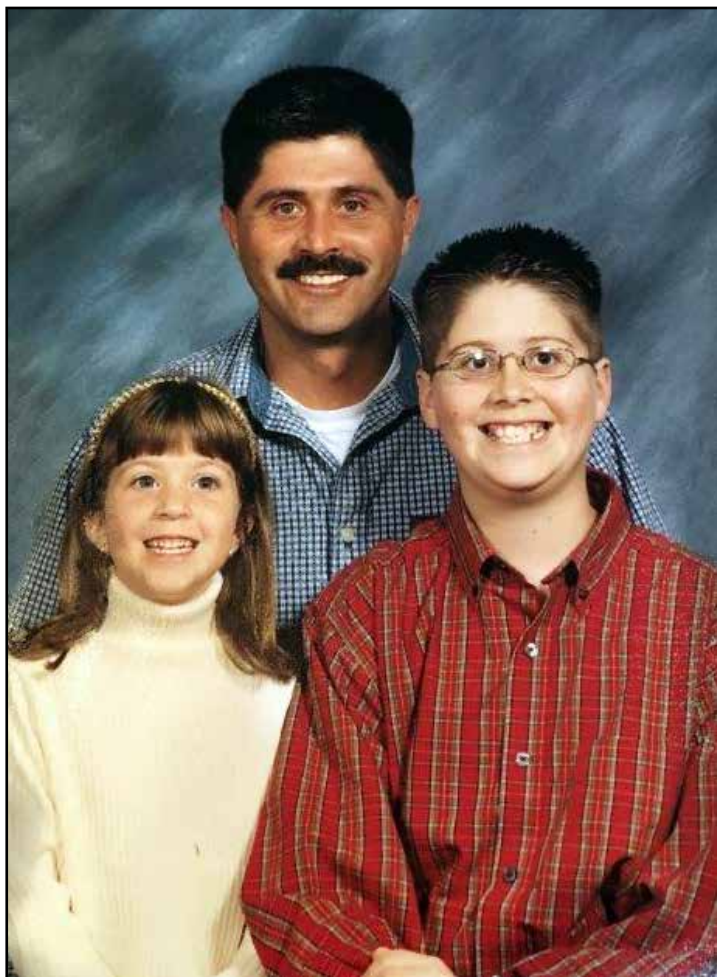


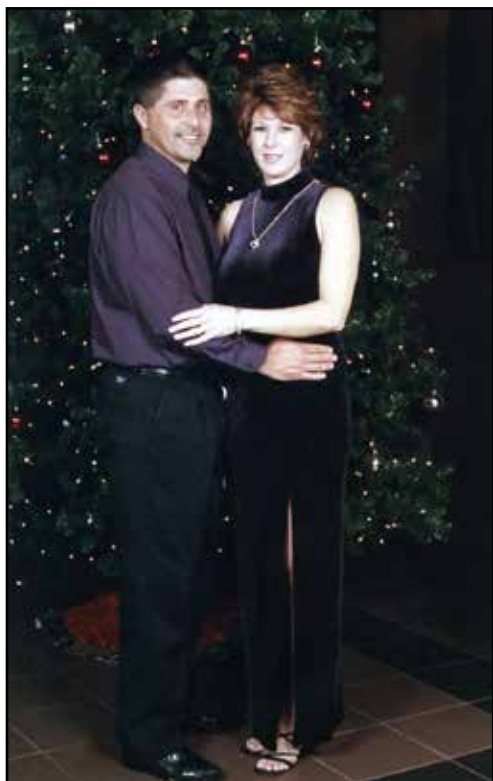
