Sherron “Sherry” Wallace-Gallier, passed away on Saturday, August 3, 2019, at Christus St. Elizabeth Hospital in Beaumont, Texas. She was 73 years old. Sherry put up a brave fight with Lewy Body Dementia and Parkinsonism for 5 years. Sherry always did things her way, and in the end she left the way she wanted to; still in the fight!

Sherry was born May 10, 1946, to parents Walt Wallace and Liwana Wallace. She loved hunting and cooking wild game. In her early years, she married and was able

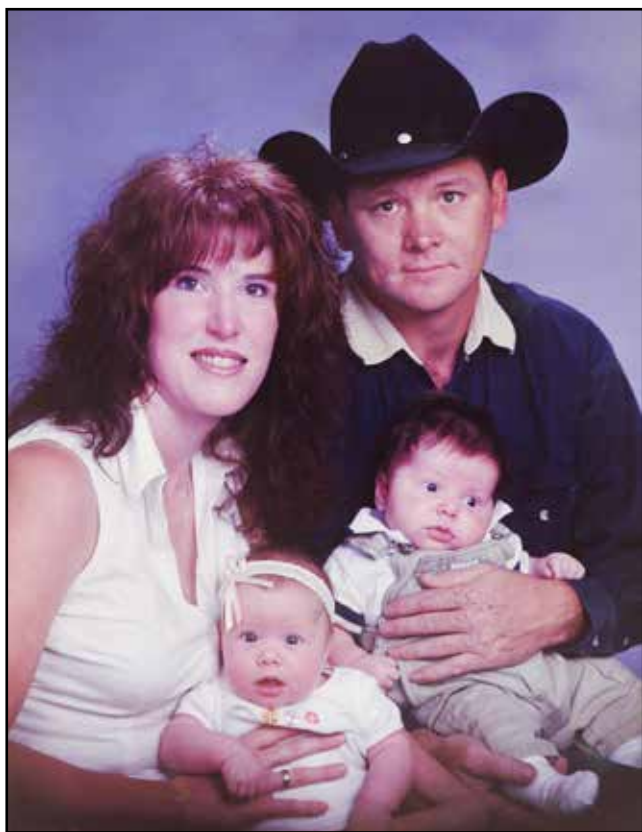

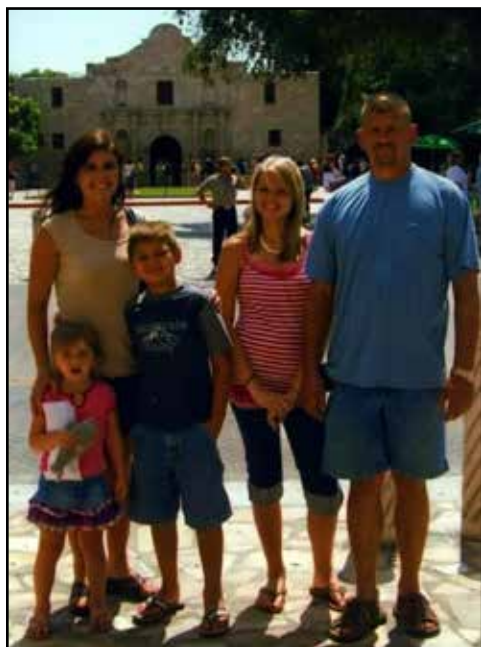
