August 6, 1966 - March 25, 2019



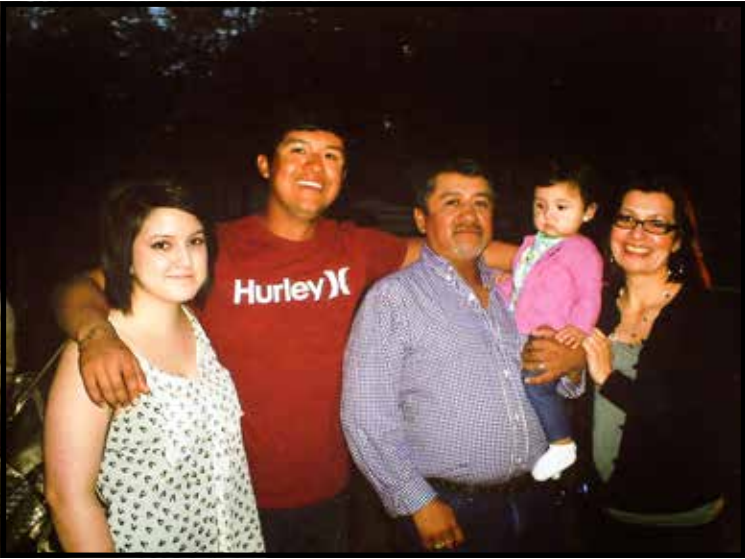

will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.*





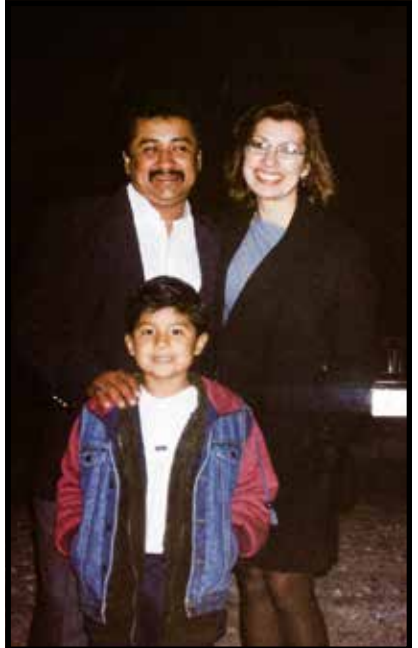
